The feature is a one room prairie school on a foundation of poured concrete. The gable roof of the main body and the north addition are covered with asphalt shingles and the half hip roofed entry also has asphalt shingles. There is a newer concrete chimney at the north end of the main body of the school. The soffits are closed. The main body of the school measures 24 1/2 feet north to south by 18 feet east to west, the addition on the north end of the school measures 12 feet east to west by 8 feet north to south and entry measures 10 feet north to south by 16 feet east to west.

The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim. On the west side of the main body of the school there is one double hung window with a storm window and a couple areas where it looks like an opening might have been filled in with siding. On the north addition there is one double hung window on each side, east and west, also with storm windows. On the east wall of the school there is bank of double hung windows with storms. Two more double hung windows are either side of the newer, solid core entry door. Glass intact with the exception of the upper window to the right of the entry door, it was shot out during hunting season. There is a concrete apron at the entry. The interior of the school is very well kept. There is a 5 panel wood door leading into the school from the entry/coat room and another 5 panel wood door leading into the north addition. There is a transom window over the door into the addition. It looks like that addition was used as a kitchen at some point. The walls in the entry are finished with beadboard. The floor is tongue and groove throughout. Inside the main room of the school as well as the north addition the walls are covered with wallboard and there is no wainscot. The ceiling is also finished with wallboard. There is oil burning stove at the north end of the main room of the school. There are valances on the windows. There is a blackboard on most of the west wall. There are electric light fixtures inside the school as well as a small electric heater over the door coming in from the entry.

There is a flag pole in the front of the entry of the school and two small outhouses off the northeast corner of the school. *Care taker called this school Heimes School #10.*
