The feature is a one room prairie school sitting on a concrete foundation. The hip roof is covered with asphalt shingles and soffits are closed with beadboard. The concrete block chimney has fallen off the roof and lies in the yard. The building measures 28 1/2 feet north to south and 28 1/2 feet east to west.

The siding begins under the soffits with a wide trim board. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim and as a finish at the bottom of the walls there is a skirting board with water table. There are two nonconforming double hung windows on the east wall with visible seams where siding filled in other openings, perhaps larger windows. On the south side there is one nonconforming double hung window. On the west side there are two double hung windows that might be original to the school, also on the wall is a 5 panel wood door for entry into the school. Above the door there is an outside light fixture suggesting the presence of electricity. The north wall had three areas that were filled in and may have been windows. Entering the school from a concrete apron there is a small entry with a second 5 panel wood door giving access to the main room of the school. Inside the school the walls are a mixture of lathe and plaster and sheet rock. The sheet rock was used in the areas where windows were closed in. There is picture molding about 2 feet down from the ceiling. At the bottom of the walls there is a wide decorative trim board. Decorative moldings can be see above the interior doors. There are two small room on the west side of the school, used for a fuel oil barrel and storage. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood and the ceiling is wallboard. There is blackboard on the south wall. No wainscot.

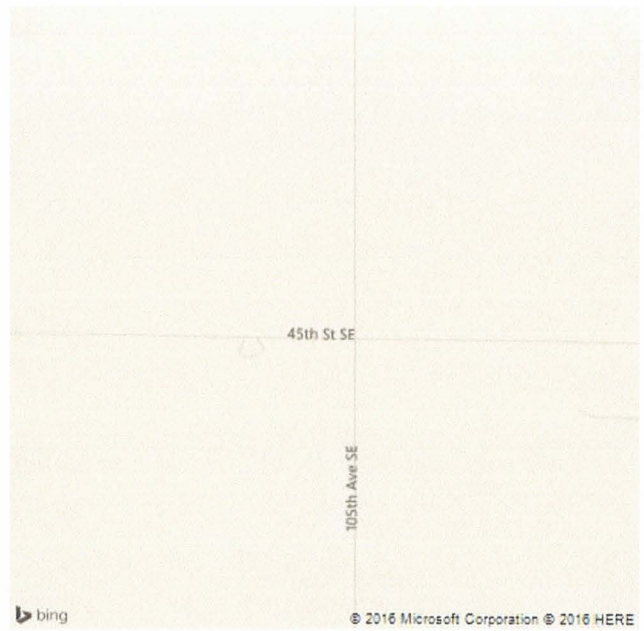
