The feature is a simple, wood framed one room prairie school house on a concrete foundation. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles with metal capping a ball finials. Near the east end of the peak is a flag pole and at the west end if a yellow, brick chimney. The eaves have closed soffits. The building measures 20 feet 4 inches north to south and 22 feet east to west. There is a small roof hanging on the east side to five protection over the door. Beaver TWP. is printed on a board that is just under the peak of this small porch roof.

A wide header runs under the eaves at both the east and west peaked ends. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. The entry door is old wood and is reached by one small piece of concrete for a step. There is not entry or coat room. The main room of the school has wall board on the walls and sheets of tile on the ceiling. There is no wainscot. The floor is hardwood tongue and groove. There is a blackboard on the south half of the west wall and along 1/2 of the north wall plus more on the east wall to the south of the entry door. There is one 2 pane, double hung window on the north wall and five 2 pane, double hung windows on the south side, all with intact glass. There is an oil burning stove on the center of the west wall and a wood burning stove in the northwest corner. The building has been most recently used for voting purposes. Ceiling light fixtures give evidence of electricity.

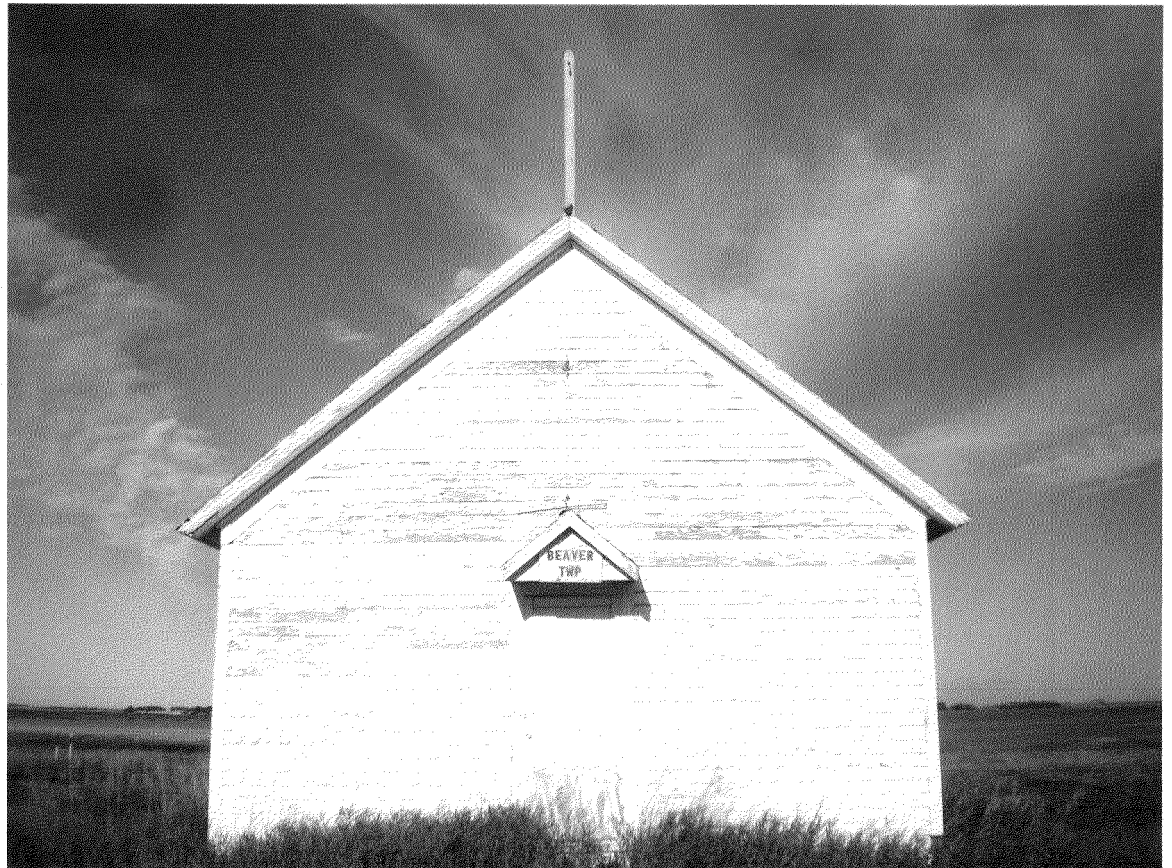

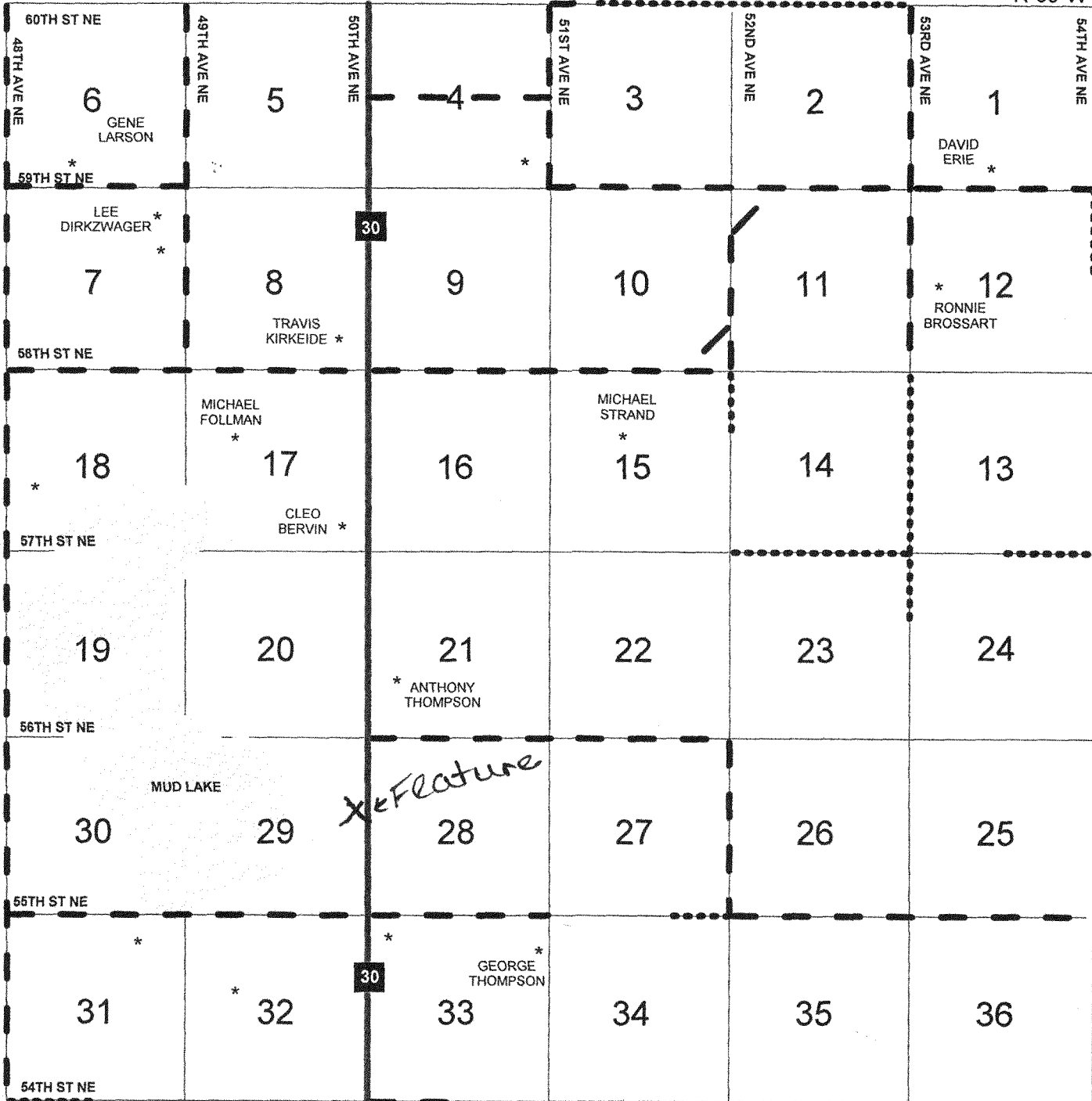
