1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school house placed on a poured concrete foundation. This building was moved to the current location. It is now being used by the family as a butcher shop.

The roof is covered with metal sheeting with metal capping. The soffits are closed. There is a concrete chimney on the north, hip slope of the building. The roof of the school blends gable roofing with a partial hip roof at the north end of the main part of the building and a half hip over the entry. There is a wide trim board running just under the eaves on the east, west and north sides of the building as well as a trim board following the roofline at the south end of the main part of the building. The siding is original 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. All the windows have been replaced with updated, double hung windows. There are three on the east side, one on the north wall and one on the south wall of the entry. One fixed pane window is located to the right of the entry door. That door is a metal two panel bottom with glass insert top security door. A wooden platform on concrete leads to the door. The entry walls are crackled plaster with coat hooks on the west wall. The entry is split into two rooms, the one with the door gives entry into the school proper and the other half is accessed through a door inside the main room and this space is used for storage. That door is an old, 5 panel wood door. Walls of the main room are lathe and plaster. No wainscot in this building. The ceiling is a mixture of lather and plaster and wallborad. Tongue and groove hardwood covers the floor. Blackboards remain in the school and are found on the west and half of the south wall. There is electricity today. Original heat was coal. The school was closed in 1967.

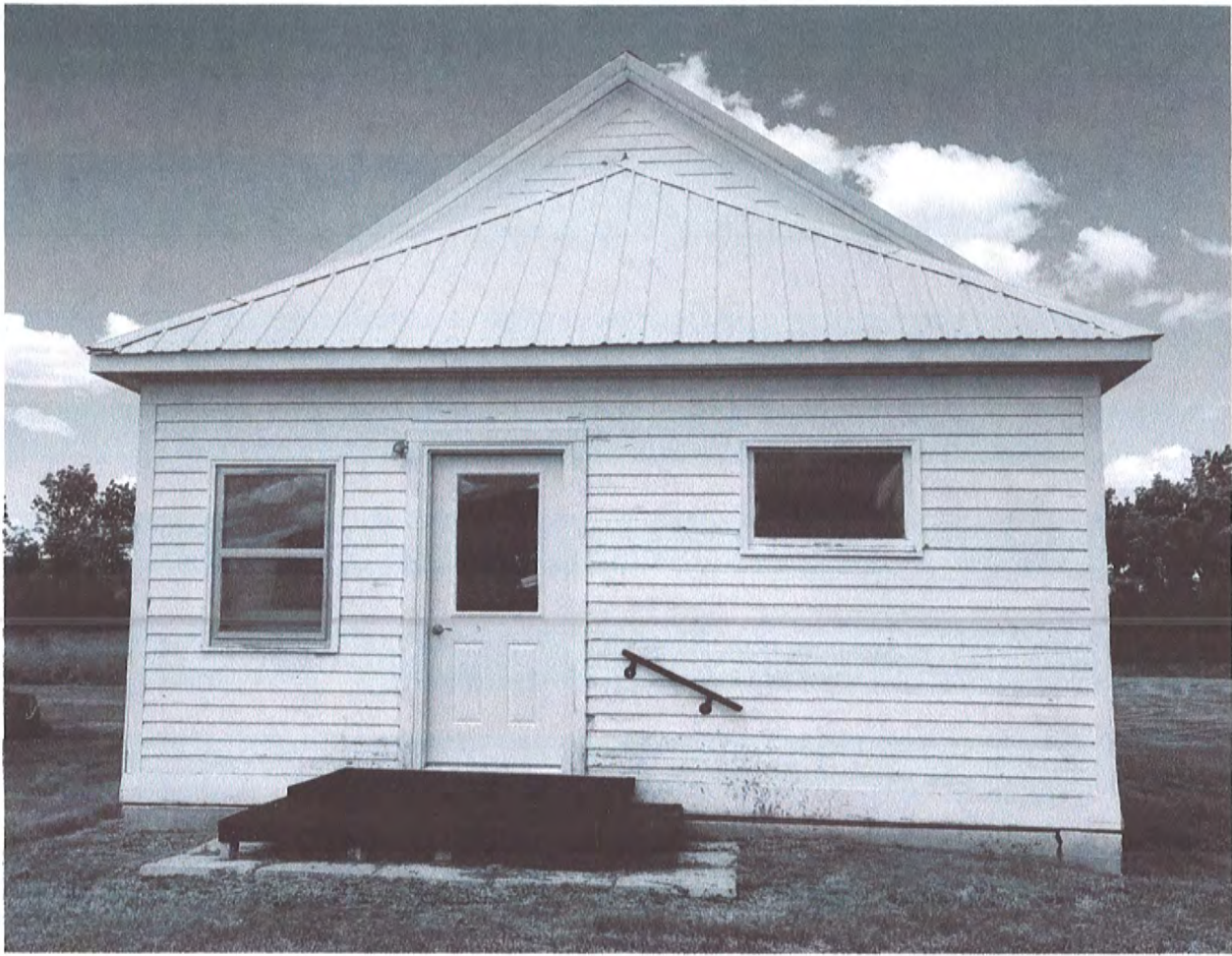

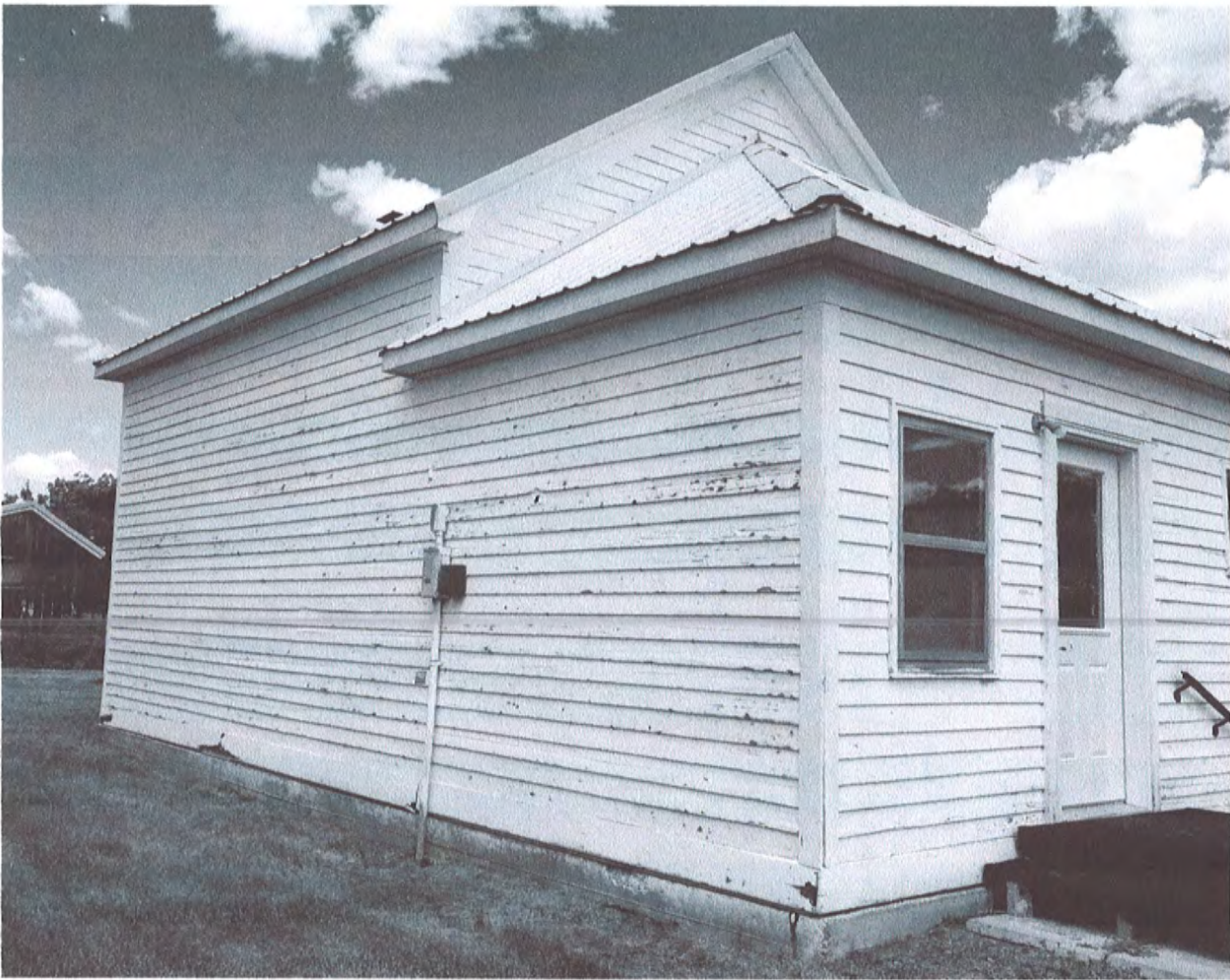

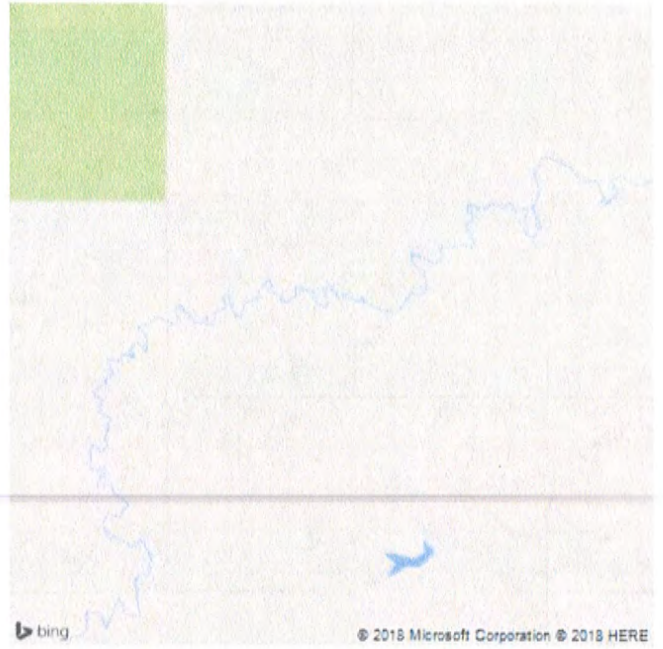
