1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school moved to a farm yard and placed on railroad ties and concrete blocks. It was moved to be used as a shop. The roof of the school is covered with metal sheeting with a newer cement block chimney at the north end of the peak of the roof. The soffits are closed. The building measures 30 feet north to south and 20 feet east to west.

There is a wide trip board running under the roof overhang at the peak ends of the school. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood comer trim. An overhead garage door has been installed in the wall of the south end of the school. To the left of this overhead door is a walk-in, 5 panel wood door. Windows on the east side of the school are 3 over 1 newer, replacement windows. More windows on the north side of the school look to be the original double hung windows. All have intact glass. On the west half of the north wall more windows look to be covered up. Also on the west wall are two more areas that have either been boarded up or covered with metal. The roof lines show what was likely an entry near the south end of the building. The interior shows a shorter ceiling as well as evidence of where the old wall was taken out. The walls and ceiling are all finished in wall board and some if starting to fall away. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There is a blackboard on the north half of the west wall. Ceiling light fixtures hand on chains with a large bulb. Could be original fixtures of the school without the old globes. Wainscot can be seen under the blackboard.




