1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The features is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete foundation. The gable roof of the entry and main body are covered with wood shakes with metal capping with finials. The shed roof of the north addition is covered with asphalt shingles. A crumbling chimney sits at the peak of the roof at the north end. The soffits are closed. The school measures 26 feet north to south and 16 feet east to west. The shed measures 12 feet east to west by 8 feet north to south and the entry measures 12 feet east to west and 8 feet north to south.

There is a wide trim board on the wall under the soffits at the peak ends of the school. The remainder of the siding on the main body of the school is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood trim. The siding on the entry is 10 inch composite siding and the addition is sided with plywood. The addition on the north side of the school has two plywood doors on the east side that swing open from the middle to give entry for stoarge. It has only studwalls. The entry is reached by way of a concrete step and a 5 panel wood door. The interior of the entry is bare to the stud walls. There are two covered windows in the entry, one south and the other west, glass intact. Another 5 panel wood door opens into the school room. There are three double hung, two over two, windows on the east and west walls, intact glass, mostly shuttered. The interior walls and ceiling are covered with wallboard, some of the panels in the ceiling are beginning to fail. There is another door on the north wall, between blackboards, that goes into the north addition. A non-functioning furnace sits in the middle of the room. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. Light fixtures suggest electricity.
