1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a foundation of poured concrete. The gable roof of the school has about half the wood shakes remaing with almost none on the plank roof of the entry. There is not chimney. The soffits are closed. The chimney opening is covered with metal sheeting. The building measures 16 feet east to west by 30 feet north to south and the entry measures 12 feet by 12 feet.

There is a wide trim board on the wall under the soffits at the peak ends of the school and entry. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood trim. There is not a speck of paint on this building. The entry is two parts, the north half has flooring that is falling onto the ground with a small window opening to the east, no glass and stripped walls. The south part of the entry has gravel flooring, stud walls and one small window opening to the school has walls covered with beadboard with the lower third covered by shiplap. The ceiling is also covered with beadboard. There are three window openings on both the east and west walls, some framing, some half covered, a bit of framing and no glass. There are decorative cornices above the window frames inside the school. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There are two blackboards across the entire north wall. The pyramid top of a bell tower sits beside the east entry wall. The building is used for storage.
