A very modern building sits on the original location of Manning #45. The first school was Manning #2 and it was build in the early 1880's. It burned down about 1981/82. What we have today is a modern building with an operational elementary school. The building measures 30 feet north to south and 40 feet east to west.

The school is a one story building with two rooms for separate classrooms for grades K-4 and 5-8. The roof of the building is covered with asphalt shingles. Soffits are enclosed with metal material that is vented. Siding is red, steel lap siding with the same red metal corner trim. There is not a chimney as the heat in the building is electric.

The windows are all 2 lite sliders and a couple of the windows have room side airconditioners. Windows also have screens. The doors, reached by concrete steps on both the south and east sides, are modern, solid core doors that remained locked. The teacher arrived as we were looking at the outside of the school and invited us to take a look inside. The entry/coat room is just inside the south door. The flooring is carpet and the walls and ceiling are sheetrock. One small chalk board is on the north wall and other walls have white boards. It is a modern classroom with many books and electronic items. They also have indoor plumbing so the children have bathrooms available.

The school is also used for voting in the township.

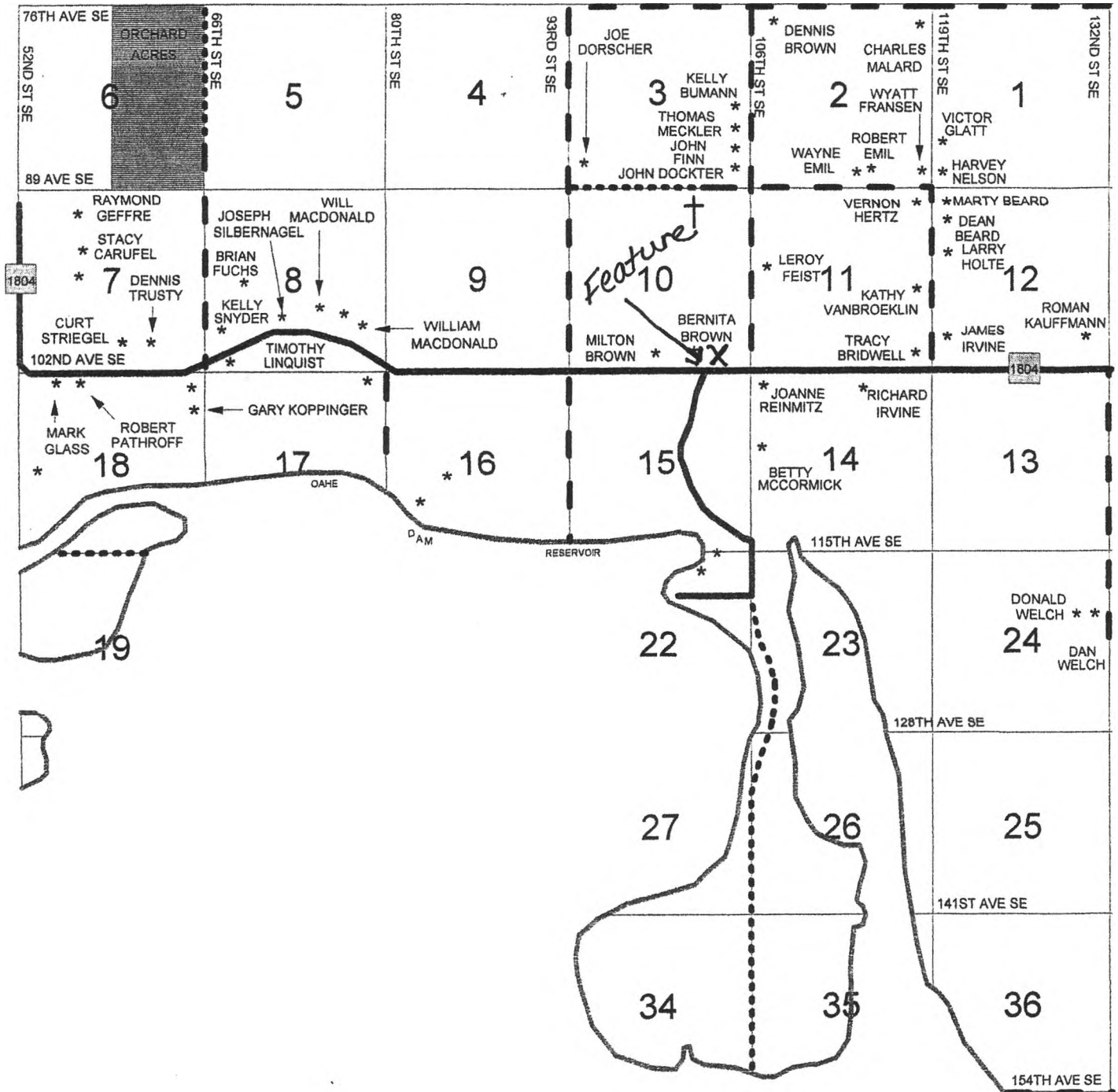
