This one room prairie school is a wonderful example of the country school in the day. It came from Lein Township near Arena and Wing and was donated to Buckstop Junction in 1993. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles. A bell tower is located at the east end of the roof with a bell inside the tower and a flag pole at the hip roof peak of that little structure. The bell is operable and was donated by a couple from Arena, ND in 1996. The chimney is original and located near the west end of the main body of the school. The school measures 34 1/2 feet east to west and 18 1/2 feet north to south.

There is an 8 inch header board running under the peaked ends of the school as well as the entry. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. The paint is in great shape. All the soffits are enclosed. There are three pairs of windows on the south side of the main body of the school. The windows are double hung, 6 panes on the top half and a single pane on the bottom of each window. There also windows in the entry, three of the windows are small, two pane, double hung windows with a third that matches the larger windows. A 6 panel door leads into the entry from a wood single step porch. There are wood, spindle railings either side of the porch.

The entry has coat hooks and shelves for lunch boxes. The flooring is hardwood tongue and groove. The walls are lathe and plaster, all painted white. An 8 inch wide trim board is located at the bottom of all the walls. There is a narrow storage room at the north side of the entry, accessed through the school room. The entry also has two more small closets for storage and etc. Heat vents along the floor in the entry and inside the main body of the school suggest that the school might have sat on a basement at one time.

Inside the main school room there are blackboards on the east and part of the north walls. A map box hangs on the north wall as well. The school is furnished with student desks, teachers desk, books in bookcases, pictures on the wall and an old wood burning stove. Also includes a piano and victrola, not so common in early school. The building has electricity.

The school was operational from 1906 to 1958, according to records kept by Buckstop Junction.

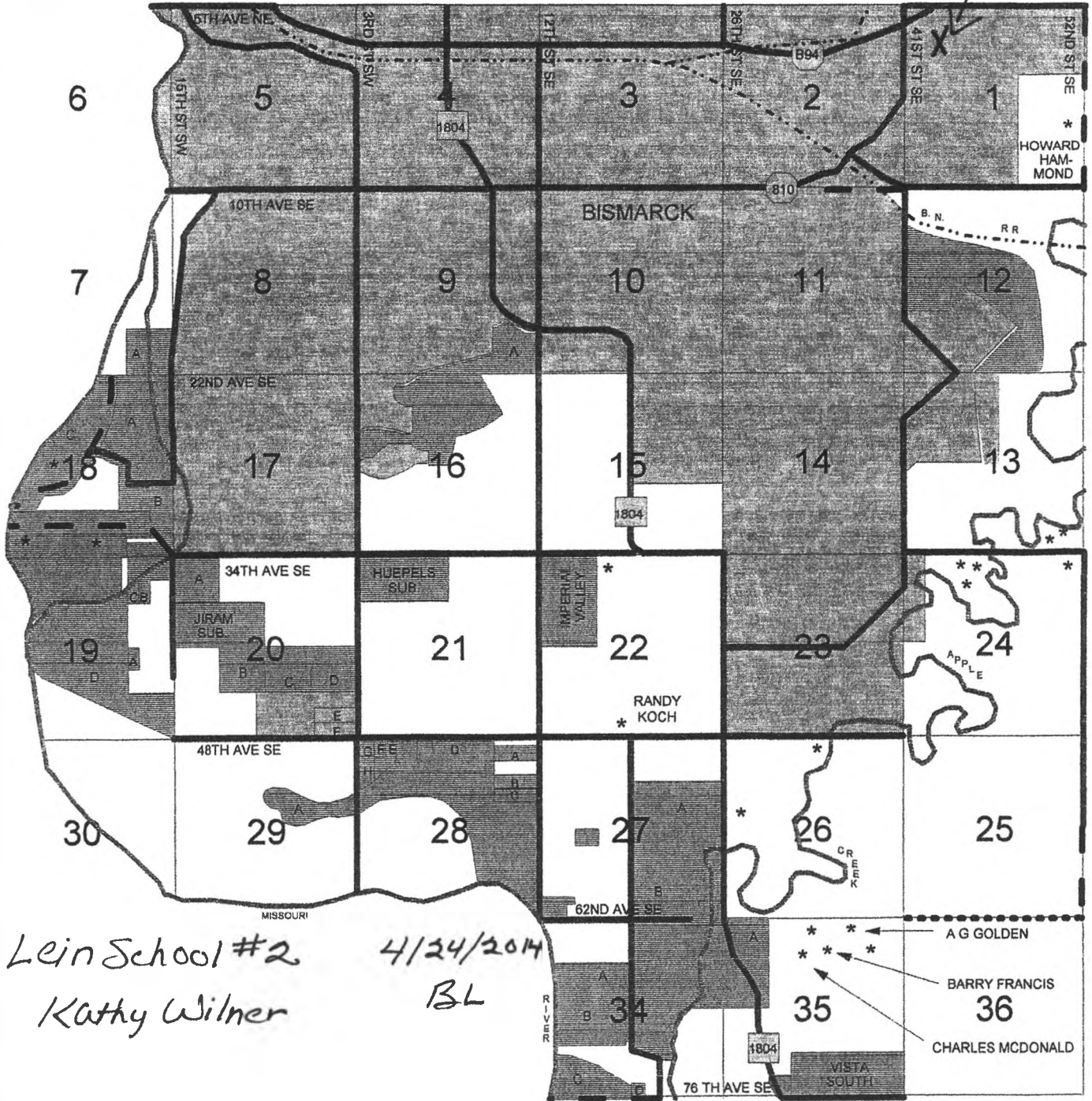
