The feature is a one room prairie school sitting on a concrete foundation. The gable roof of both the main body and entry of the school is covered with asphalt shingles over roof sheathing. The chimney is of orange brick on a cement block base. The building measures 16 feet north to south and 28.5 feet east to west.

There is a header running under the roof eaves at both peaks. The remainder of siding is 6 inch lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. There are three double hung windows on the south wall of the main body. Two of the windows are double paned and all three have screens. Window glass is intact. There is another smaller window on the east wall, it is a four pane fixed glass window. On the north wall of the entry there is another opening, boarded shut, that might have been for fuel.

A 5 panel wood door gives entry from a concrete step. The entry is stripped down to the lumber supporting the lap siding. There is no ceiling here either. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. A second 5 panel door opens into the main body of the school. Once again tongue and groove hardwood covers the floor. The walls here are 1 x 4's running horizontally up the walls to rounded corners and then across the ceiling. The north wall has wall board from the west to east end and up about 6 feet. There is also a blackboard on the north wall. The south half of the west wall also has a blackboard. There is a fuel oil stove in the northwest corner. Electricity is present.
