The feature is a simple wood frame school house. The foundation couldn't be seen. Asphalt shingles cover the roof of the house as well as the entry. There is no chimney and that opening was covered. A pole at the west end of the main body of the school looks to have been a flag pole. The main body of the school measures 24 feet 4 inches east to west and 18 feet 4 inches north to south. The entry measures 8 by 8 feet.

The eaves have closed soffits. There is a wide header under the peak ends of the school as well as the entry. Siding is 6 inch wide wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. The paint is looking tired. The school has 3 double hung windows on the south side, glass is intact. On the north side there are three openings with plywood covering them, most likely windows at one time. The entry, from a concrete step, has a 4 panel wood door with part of a lower panel missing. The entry has beadboard on the walls and ceiling with rounded corners at the top of the walls. The floor is tongue and groove hard wood in both the entry and main body of the school. There is a 5 panel wood door leading into the main body of the school. The north wall in the main body is paneled, covering windows. The other three walls are of lathe and plaster with wainscoat on the lower 1/3 of the wall. Light fixtures hang from a ceiling covered with beadboard. There are blackboards on the west wall, near the door, and more on the south wall to the right of the west window and between the other windows same wall.

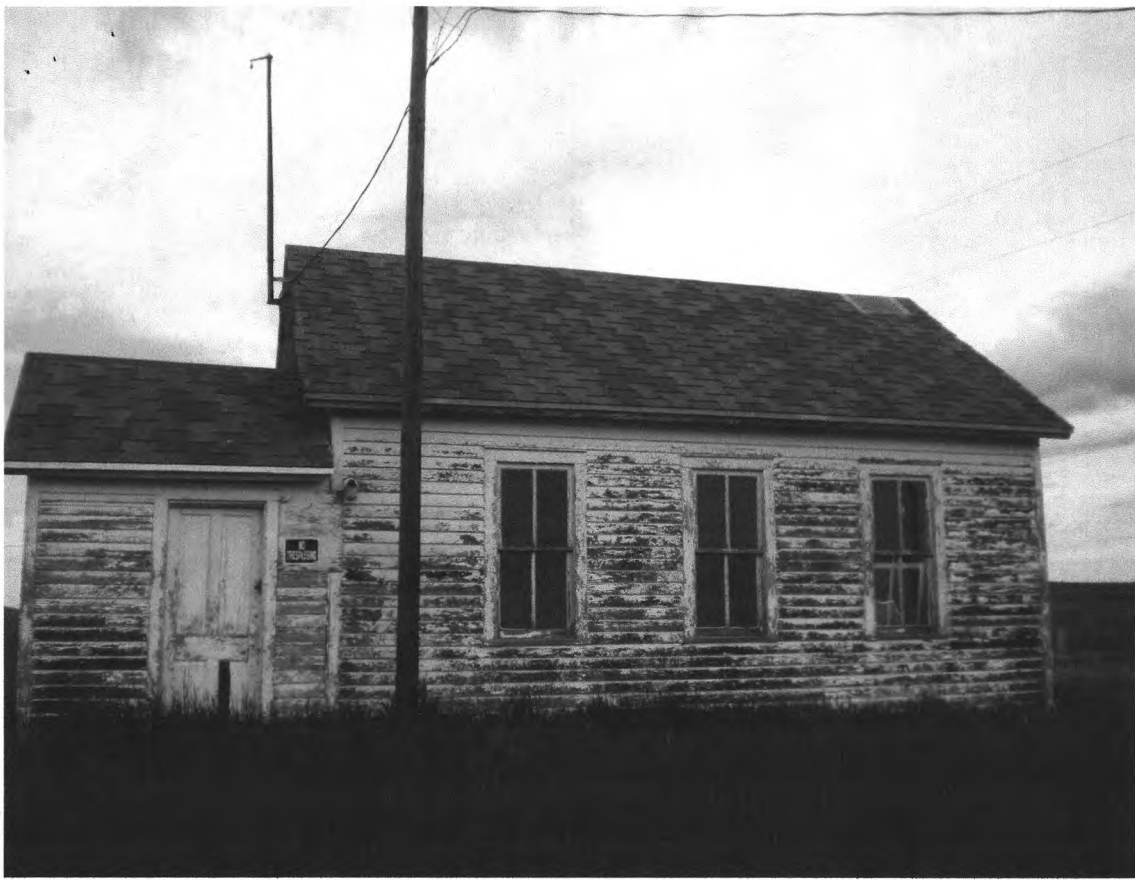

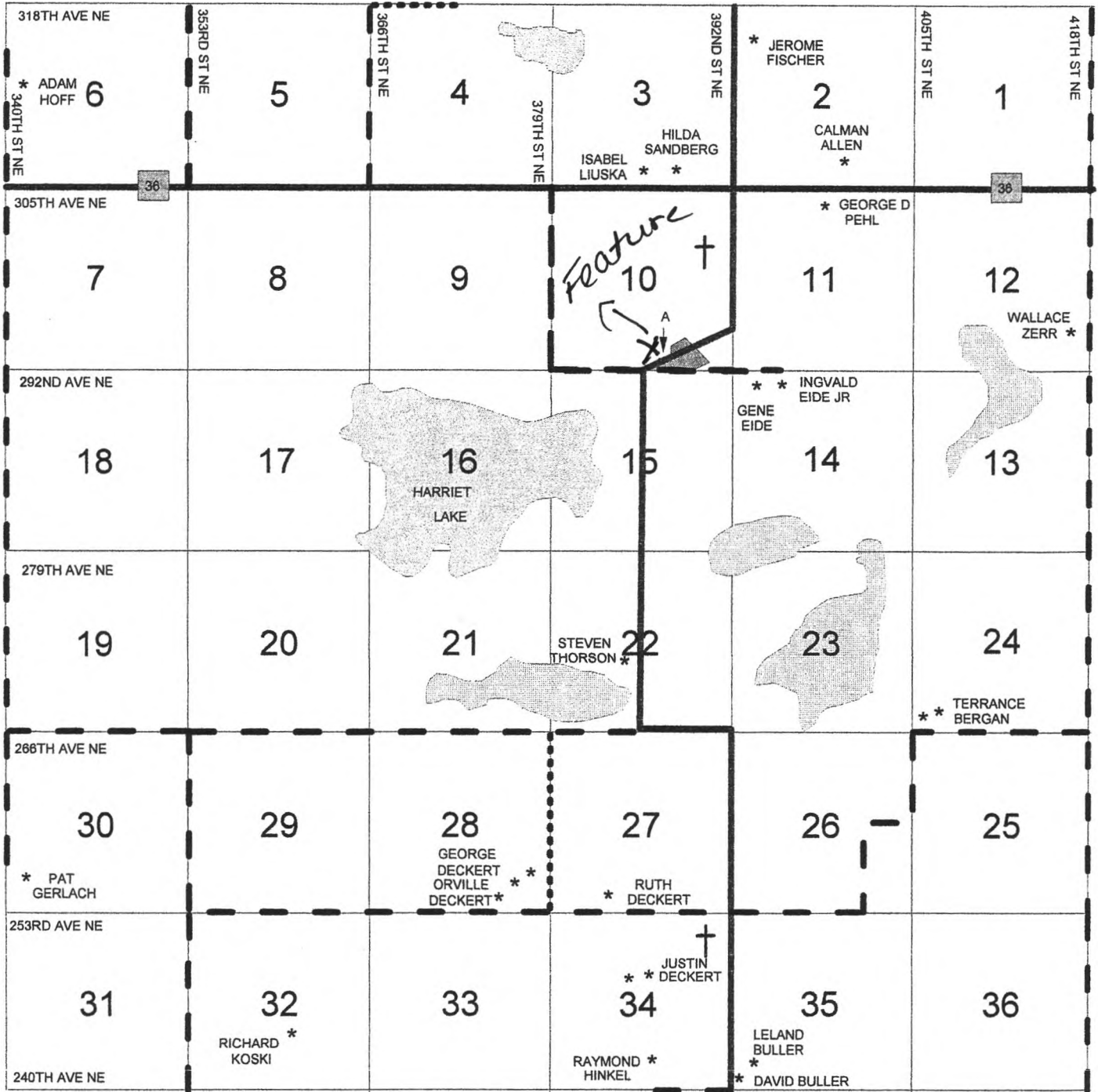
