The feature is a large wood framed prairie school. It may have been two or four rooms, depending on what use they made of the basement. The hip roof of the main body of the school is covered with wood shakes over wood sheathing. At the peak and at all four corners of the roof there is metal ridge capping with ball finials at the end on the peak of the roof. The peaked roof of the entry is also covered with wood shakes topped by a metal ridge cap with a ball finial at the outside end. There is a flag pole at the peak of the entry roof. A red brick chimney with concrete cap is located on the west slope of the hip roof. There is an air exchanger at the point where the entry roof ties into the hip roof for allowing the hot air to get out of the attic space. The eaves are closed with beadboard finishing the soffits.

The building measures 56 feet north to south and 28 feet east to west. The entry is 5 feet deep by 20 feet wide.

The building sits high on the poured concrete basement. The concrete walls above the ground are decorative in nature on the north and south sides. There are several covered windows in the basement, 3 both north and south and 6 on the west side. There are also two covered windows at either side of the entry, located below the wood walls of the school. The walls of the school are 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. Paint is getting tired. There is a wide header running under the eaves on all four sides as well as at the peaked end of the east entry. Windows are a hodgepodge. On the east side entry there are two large miltipane windows with some of the glass is missing. In the middle of the entry is a 5 panel wood door in the middle. Part of the door has been broken in. Above the windows and door there is a small roof piece for decoration with a moon shaped opening above that, under the roof peak. The north wall has three sets of two side slider windows, the west side has two very small, fixed pane windows and on the south side there is a bank of 4 fairly large windows, fixed on the top and awning windows at the bottom. Also on the south side there as another 5 panel wood door, reached by some rickety looking wood steps.

I didn't go into the school but could look through broken door. I saw stairs curving off to the north and south of the entry, going to the basement. Looking straight in the door I saw a wide wood staircase leading up to the classroom level. Wainscot was either side of the stairs as well as the wall at the top. Entry into the school was through a door opening that had a transom above it, glass intact. The floor I saw was tongue and groove hardwood. Walls of lathe and plaster, ceiling as well. A light fixture above the entry shows electricity the prescence of electricity in the school.

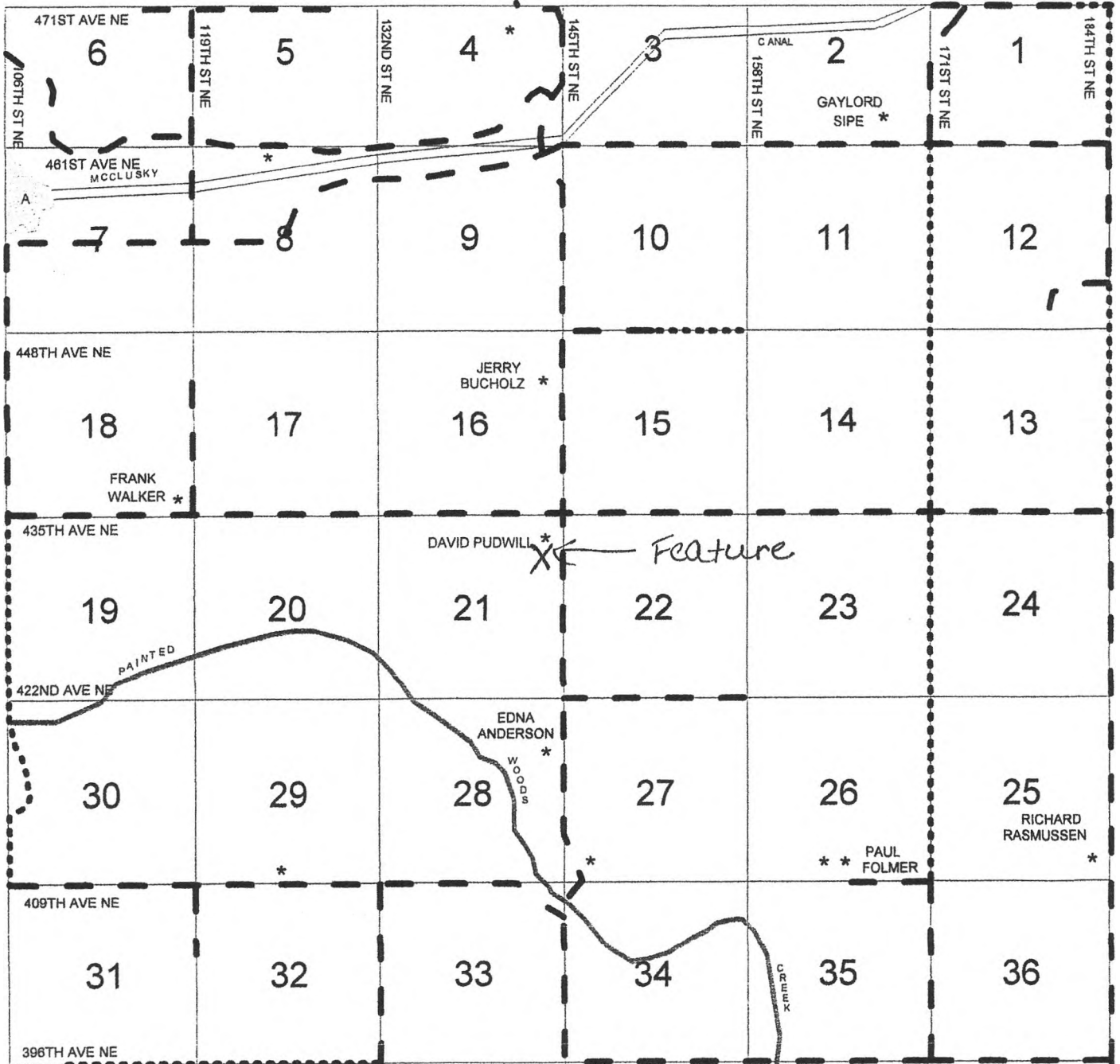
