### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a town hall today but the interior tells it is a one room prairie school on a concrete foundation which has been covered with metal sheeting. The gable roof is covered with wood shakes with metal capping. A small, brick chimney is at the peak of the roof near the east end. The sofffits are closed. The building mearures 32 feet east to west and 25 feet north to south.

The siding of this building is vertical, metal ribbed sheeting over. The double hung windows, three on the south side and three on the west side, are all replacement double hung windows with storm windows. There is a small entry on the east side and the shed roof is covered with wood shakes. There is a locked wood door for entry. The interior of the school (seen through a broken window) has wallboard on the ceiling and walls. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. At the east end of the main body of the school are 5 panel doors on near south and north ends of the east interior wall which I am guessing leads to the coatrooms. There are transoms with intact glass above both doors. Two small blackboards are on the east wall on either side of the chimney and another blackboard runs the length of the north wall. Electric light fixtures inside the school indicate electricity.


