1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room school moved to the present location from somewhere between Bottineau and Gardena. It is sitting on a concrete foundation. A red brick chimney sits at the peak of the school at the west end of the roof. The roof is covered with wood shakes. The soffits are open.

A rake board begins the siding just under the roof at the peak ends. The remaining siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. The exterior of the school has a lovely coat of white paint. A 5 panel wood door gives access to the interior of the school. This is reached by a new wood porch/walkway built to accomodate traffic. There is no separate entry or coat room. You enter directly into the school room. There are three two over two double hung windows on both the south and north sides of the school. All have intact glass and window shades. The walls and sloped ceiling of the school are covered with 2 x 4 wood boards, running the lenght of the school and installed horizontally on the walls. The same narrow wood boards run vertically along the lower third of the wall as wainscot. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. A small wood burning stove is located about 8 feet straight inside the door with the stove pipe running up near the ceiling and then along the school room to the chimney, all held up with sires. No evidence of electricity. There is one blackboard on about 2/3 of the west wall.

The interior of this school is furnished with desks, books, teachers desk, wash stand, maps and much more. The school was built in 1886 and closed in 1941.

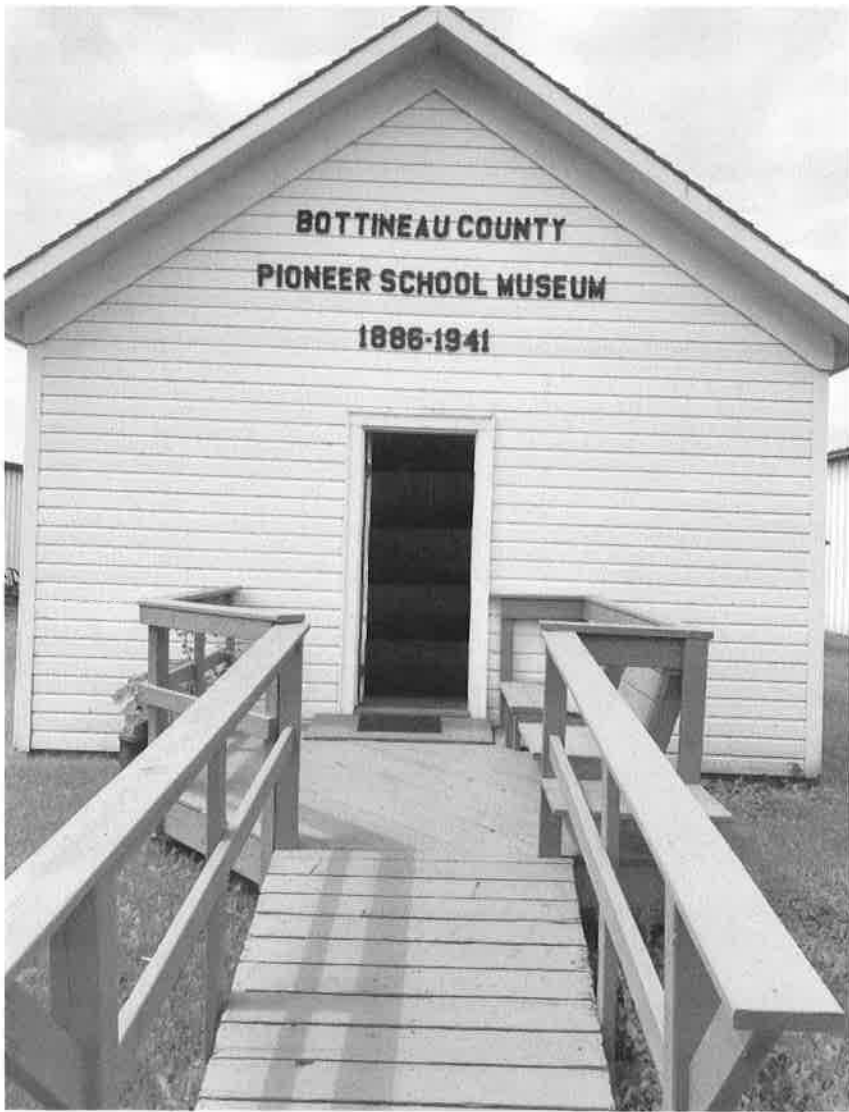

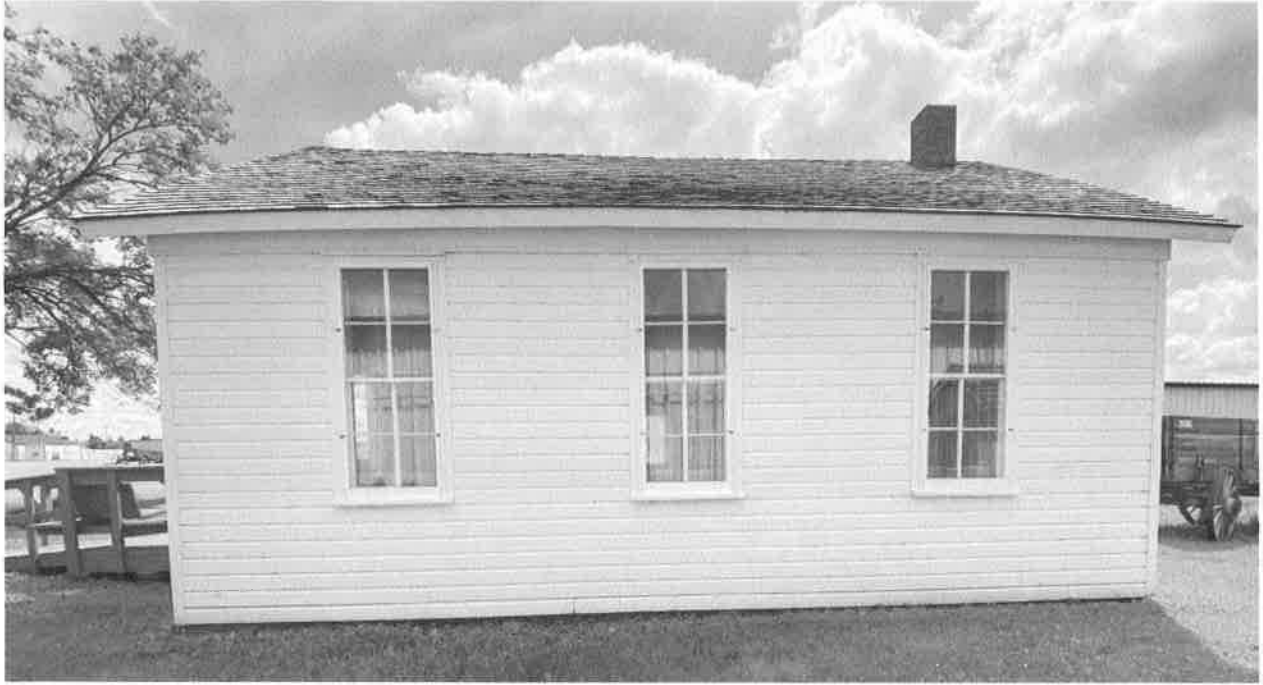

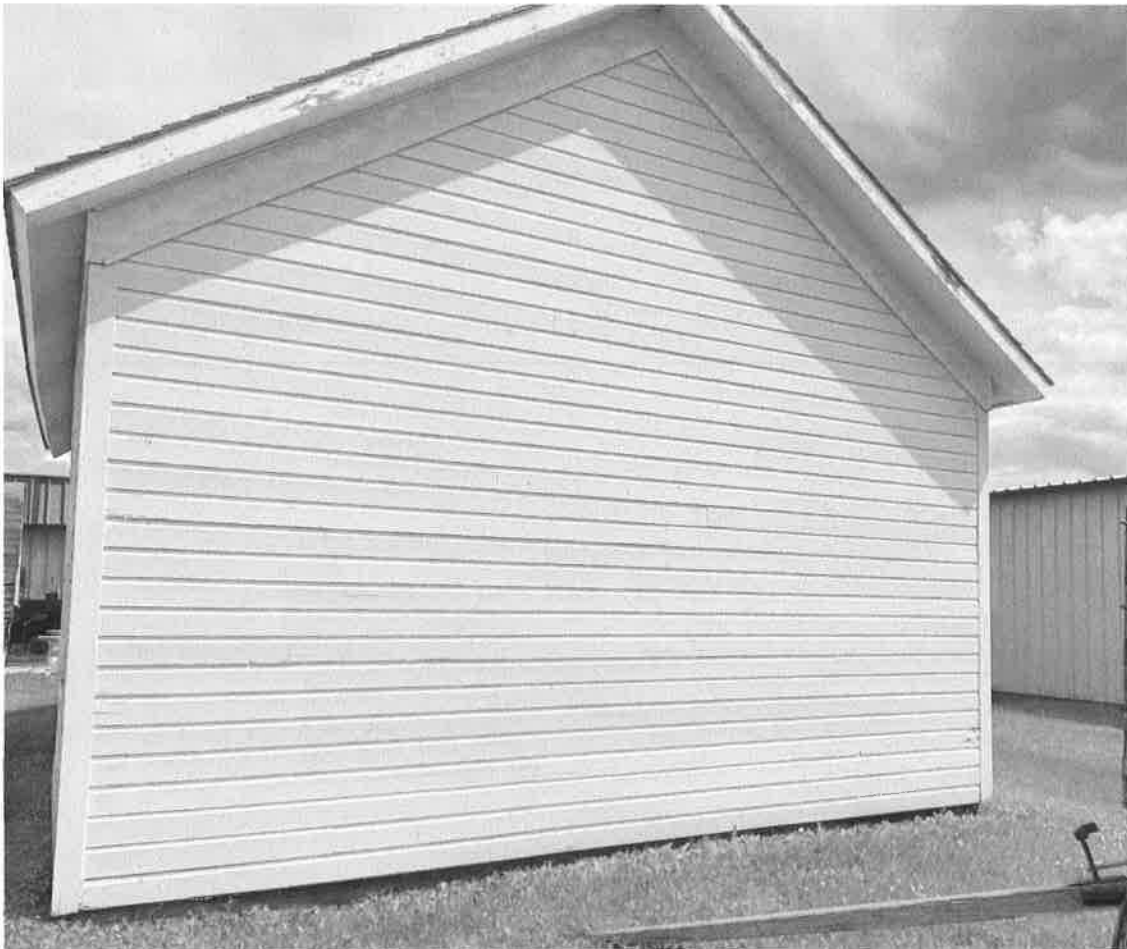
