1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school. The building was moved to this location to be used as a teacherage. The gable roof of both the school and entry are covered with asphalt shingles with metal capping and finials. There is a partially broken red brick chimney at the south end of the peak of the school. The soffits are closed.

A rake board begins the siding under the peaks of the roof at either end of the school as well as the gable roofed entry. The remaining siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch corner trim. There are two double hung windows on both the east and west sides of the building, some with glass and some covered. There is one double hung window facing north in the entry and there is no glass and little framing. The entry is from the west and there is no longer a door. All the interior walls in the entry have been stripped. The interior of the school building has walls separating a kitchen corner, bedroom and living space. The walls in the school are covered with beadboard and there is wainscot. There is also electricity as evidenced by outlets, switches and ceiling light fixtures. The ceiling is covered with acoustical tiles. There are no blackboards.



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
