1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school sitting on concrete blocks. This building was moved to its current loction. There are several sections of roof, all gable, as buildings were cobbled together, all covered with asphalt shingles. A new concrete block chimney was located at the peak end of the original school room. The soffits are closed.

The siding of the buildings are all 6 inch wood lap under a rake board at the peak ends. Corner trim is a mixture of metal and wood. The school was moved to a farm site and was attached to the south side a small log cabin. The original entry was removed and attached to the north side of the log cabin. There was also a granary tucked along the west end of the main school building. The interior walls are lathe and plast under paneling. The ceiling is wallboard. The interior has walls added to make rooms. Windows are mostly replacements, a large picture window was added to the east wall and above that window is a sliding window. The school was large and the ceiling could be lowered to make a second story. There are a variety of windows, double hung with glass. The original door opening in the entry as well as a window to the right were closed and filled in. There is now a door on the east side of the entry, half wood and half window, that is a replacement. A small gable roof protects the doorway. There are no blackboards left. There was electricity, now disconnected.

This school was opened in the early 1900's on a hill in the Turtle Mountains. It was closed at the end of the 1951-1952 school year.
