1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school sitting a poured concrete foundation. The gable roof of the school and entry and the shed roof of the entry addition are all covered with asphalt shingles. The yellow brick chimney is located at the west end of the roof at the peak. The soffits are closed. The building measures 30 feet by 25 feet.

A rake board begins the siding on all peak ends of the school and entry. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. There is an entry located at the east end of the school. The original part of the entry had a door facing east, that door was removed and filled in. An addition to the north side of the entry had a window facing east that was removed and replaced with a three panel wood door. The door has a two pane window at the top one third. A screen door was later added. The entry today leads up some stairs into the original entry through yet another screen door. The walls of the entry and the school room are finished with wall board. The ceiling is finished with ceiling tile panels. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There are 6 double hung, multipane windows on the south side and three more similar windows on the west side. A double hung window is also located on the south wall of the entry. All glass intact. A 5 panel wood door leads from the entry into the school room. There are blackboards along the entire north wall. The room was divided into two rooms for school in the early 1960's with the school closing in 1963. Flourescent lights were installed in both halves of the school. It is used for storage today. There is an oil burning stove in the school along with an electric heater in the wall on the opposite side from the stove.
