In 1976, the school was moved into Hampden and placed in the town park. It was restored as part of our heritage. Later it was moved to Prairie Winds and Pioneer Power site, north of Hampden. The relatively recent move and the placement of the school among a variety of other buildings to create an artificial historic site has made this school ineligible for the National Register of Historic Places.


