1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a concrete foundation. The hip roof of the school, the half hip roof of the porch and the gable roof of the dormer are all covered with asphalt shingles with some metal capping at the hips and on the dormer. The south slope of the roof has wood shakes. The soffits were closed, much of the material has fallen away. There is not chimney. There is a dormer on the west facing slope of the roof with two window openings, no glass. At the peak there is a flag pole. The building measures 38 feet east to west and 32 feet north to south with a porch that measures 20 feet north to south and 8 feet east to west.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits on all four sides of the school. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim with waterboard and a wide trim board at the bottom of the walls. The porch on the west wall of the school has three of four posts remaining, the floor is wood and the roof is sagging at the southwest corner. There are no steps to the porch and the entire south half wall has fallen to the ground. There is as 3 panel wood door with 4 pane window at the top. To either side of the entry door are two smaller double hung windows with glass. Beyond the porch, on the west wall, are two smaller fixed pane windows, one is covered. An opening on the south side is covered. The east wall has a bank of 6 double hung, two over two, windows with all but one covered and some framing and no glass in that uncovered window. There is a locked 3 panel wood door on the north wall near the west end, 4 pane fixed window at the top, that is at ground level and leads to the basement. The concrete basement is cracking in places, has a window on the north and east sides and a fuel door near the east end of the north wall.

Interior information came from a former student and she was happy to share. There is a foyer just inside the door and three doors lead to the school room, boys coat room, left, the girls coat room right with bathrooms beyond through the coat rooms. There are doors leading into the school room from each coat room. In the northwest corner of the school room is the inside stairway leading to the basement. There was a floor grate for head with the furnace in the basement. A small library was located in the southwest corner of the school room. A blackboard filled the remainder of the south wall. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. The walls and ceiling are covered with lathe and plaster. The school was operational until the early 1960's. This former student shared that their teacher had a bed in the classroom.
