This site lead was originally recorded by Mary K. in 2001 as the District 33 New Castle School. Upon the 2014 site revisit, the building appears to have been moved. Nothing related to the school could be found in its original recorded location. The current landowner believes it was moved a short distance to a new location to the west-northwest and related to an event center/hotel or used as a barn.

According to the site lead file, the New Castle School was nominated for the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) under criteria B and C. It is unclear if the keeper agreed or if the necessary research was conducted in order to list the property. As the School has been removed from its original reported location, it will likely be considered *Not Eligible*. As the structure is not within the proposed project area, no adverse effects will occur. It is also recommended that further research be done to locate the School's current location.
