1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a foundation of rocks and poured concrete. The hip roof of the main body and half hip of the entry have some wood shakeswith a lot of planking showing. Metal capping is at most of the hips. There is a tall red brick chimney at the peak of the half hip entry. The soffits are closed. A shed roof comes off the east edge of the entry roof to give cover to a porch with a supporting post at the southeast corner. The post rests on a halfwall built at the edge of the concrete stoop. The building measures 32 feet north to south and 28 feet east to west.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits on all sides of the school. The rest of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim with a waterboard and skirting board at the bottom. A 5 panel wood door opens into the entry. There are toilets at the west end of the entry with door to each. Another 5 panel wood door opens into the main school room. The interior walls and ceiling are covered with lathe and plaster with wainscot. A blackboard is on the east wall and corners around to the south wall and extends to the entry door. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There is are three double hung window openings on the south wall of the entry, 1 large and two small, bit of framing and no glass. Two small windows openings on the west side of the entry are at the location of the toilets. On the north side there is a bank of 8 window openings with little framing and no glass. Light fixtures and outside wiring suggest electricity.






