**1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:**

The feature is a one room prairie school on a foundation of poured concrete. The roof of the school, entry and cupola are covered with wood shakes. Metal capping is at the peak of the school roof as well as the hips of the bathroom addition. The exterior chimney is gone with the interior yellow brick chimney still in place. The large, wood framed base, belfry sits on the roof of the entry. There is a flag pole at the peak of the belfry. The building measures 28 feet north and south and 20 feet east to west with a 12 by 6 foot addition for the toilets on the north side and a 14 by 8 foot entry on the west. The soffits are closed.

Wide trim boards run under the eaves at the peak ends of the school and entry as well as under the eaves of the bathroom addition. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim. At the bottom edge of the siding there is a skirting board with watertable. The east side has many double hung windows with no glass and little framing, there is a bank of three windows are either side of a pair in the middle. There are two double hung windows, no glass, in the bathroom addition and another on the west side wall of the entry. To the left of the window on the west side of the entry is an opening used for loading coal into the school. On that same wall is a diamond shaped window under the peak, again no glass. The door is a 5 panel, broken wood door. All the corners of the entire building have a wrap of metal at the bottom going up about 3 feet for keeping animals out. The entry, with a covered porch approach, has two halves, the north half is used for coal storage and the south is a coat room with coat hooks still on the wall. There is a 5 panel wood door leading into the coal room and another, with half of the door broken away, leading into the school proper. The floor in the entry as well as the school proper is tongue and groove hardwood. The walls of the entry and school are covered with lathe and plaster. Some plaster has fallen from the walls in the school room. The ceiling is also lathe and plaster, much falling away there. There is wainscot on the walls of the entry, none inside the school room. An outline on the south and west wall indicate where the blackboards were located. No indication of electricity.

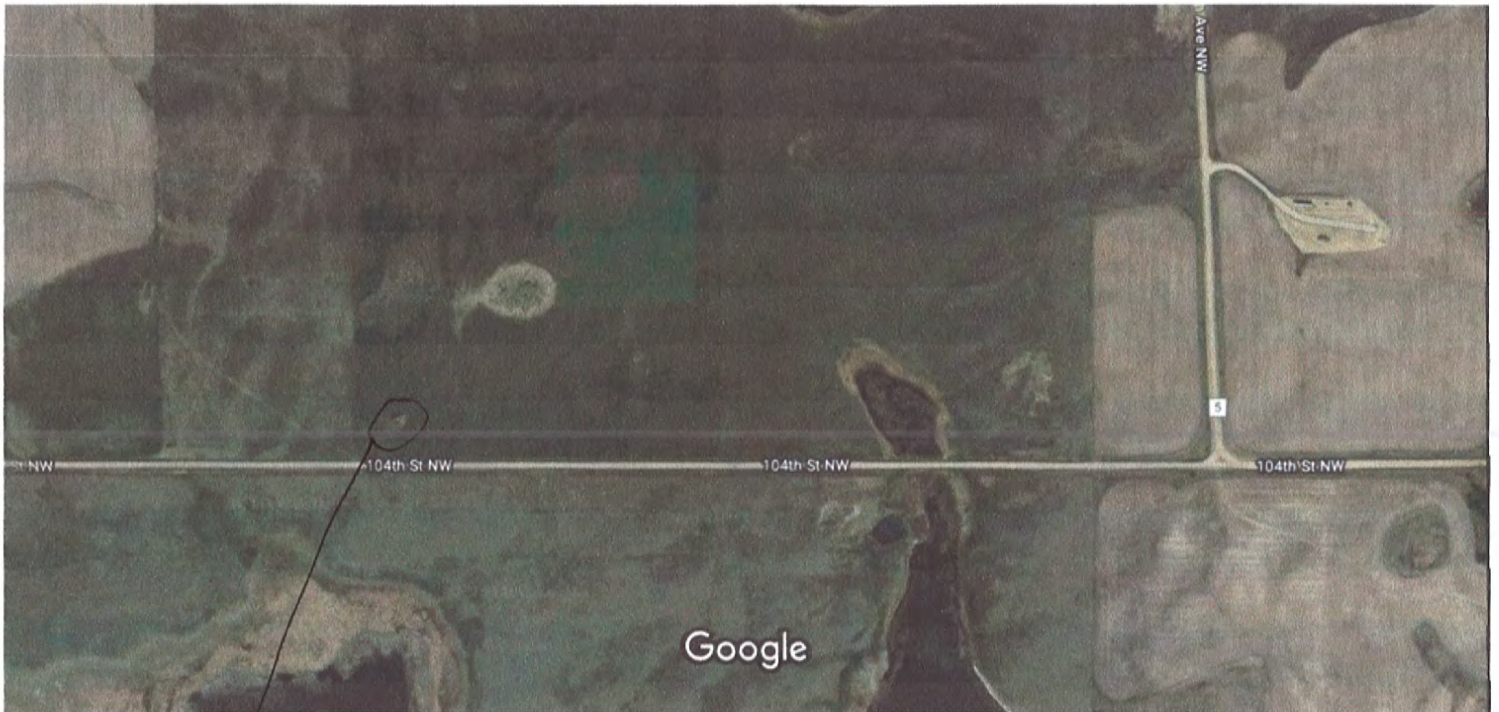
