**1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:**

The feature is a one room prairie school on a concrete foundation. The roof is covered with wood shakes, many in very tough shape. A half hip roof covers an addition on the south side of the school that likely housed the bathrooms. Remnants of a bell tower can be seen at the peak of the entry roof. Some metal capping and finials remain.

A rake board begins the siding under all the peaked roof ends. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. This school design is similar to many located in the northwest counties of North Dakota. There is a 5 panel wood door leading into the entry. Any support column for the overhang of the entry is missing. There are two covered windows on the west side of the entry with one of them being a diamond shape up under the roof peak. There is also a covered opening that was likely a fuel door. Covered windows on the east side look to be two sets of three windows either side of a pair of windows, all covered. Did not go into the school for interior information. Wires on the exterior of the school would indicate electricity was present at some point.

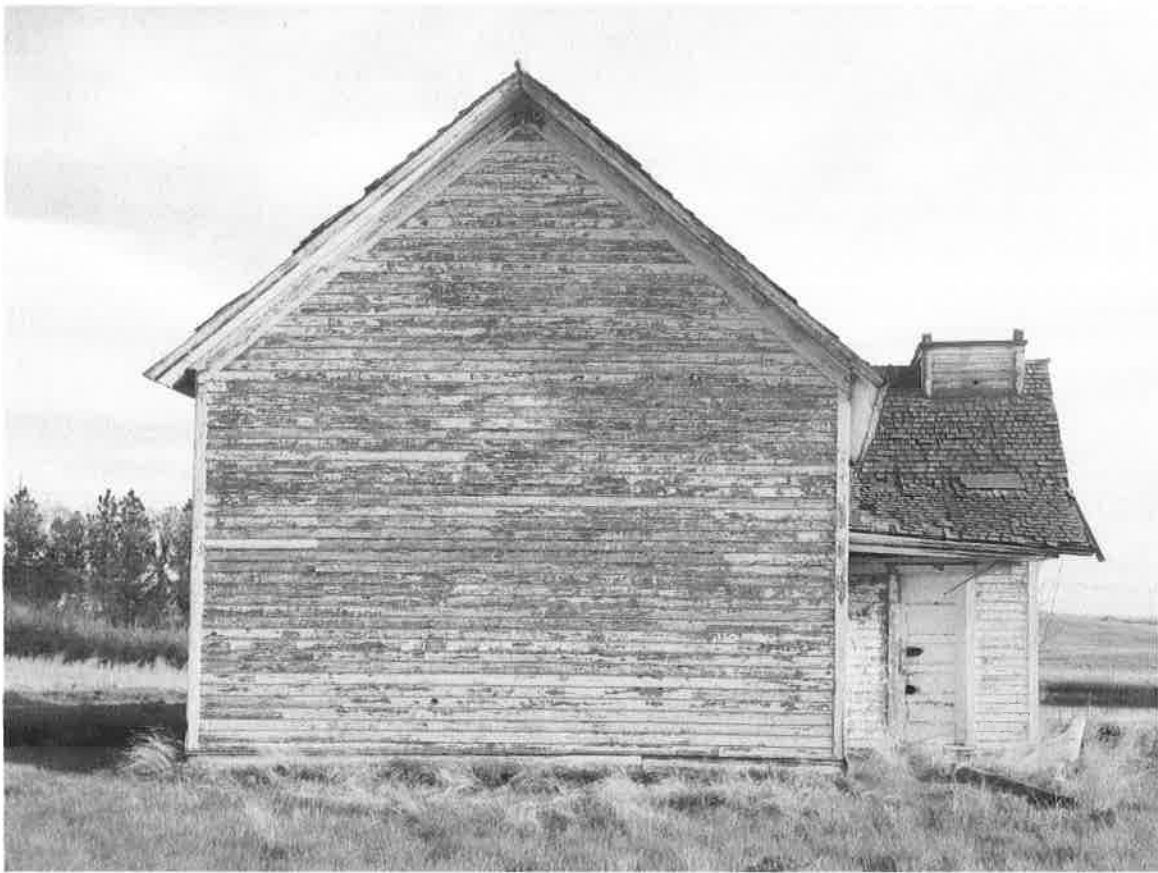
