The building has wood lap siding and wood shake shingles, many of which are missing. The south side of the building has a boarded up opening to the left of the door. The door is several piece of wood nailed to cross pieces. We could see would floor along the edges of the door. It looks like there was a porch/entry on the south side of the building as the paint follows the line of where the roof might have been.

In speaking with the current owners of this building they tell me that it was used as a Township meeting hall and for church services. It was moved to this location and they think it might have been a school somewhere else in the township.

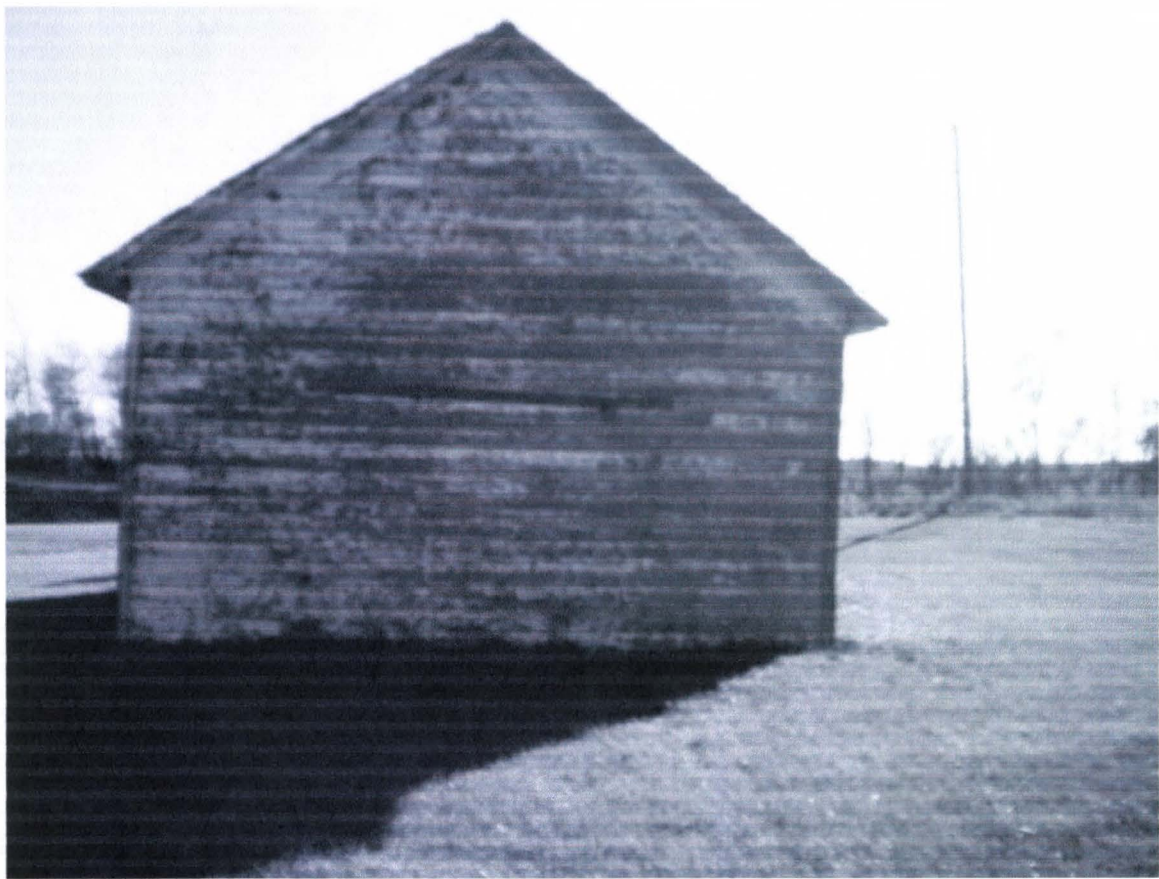

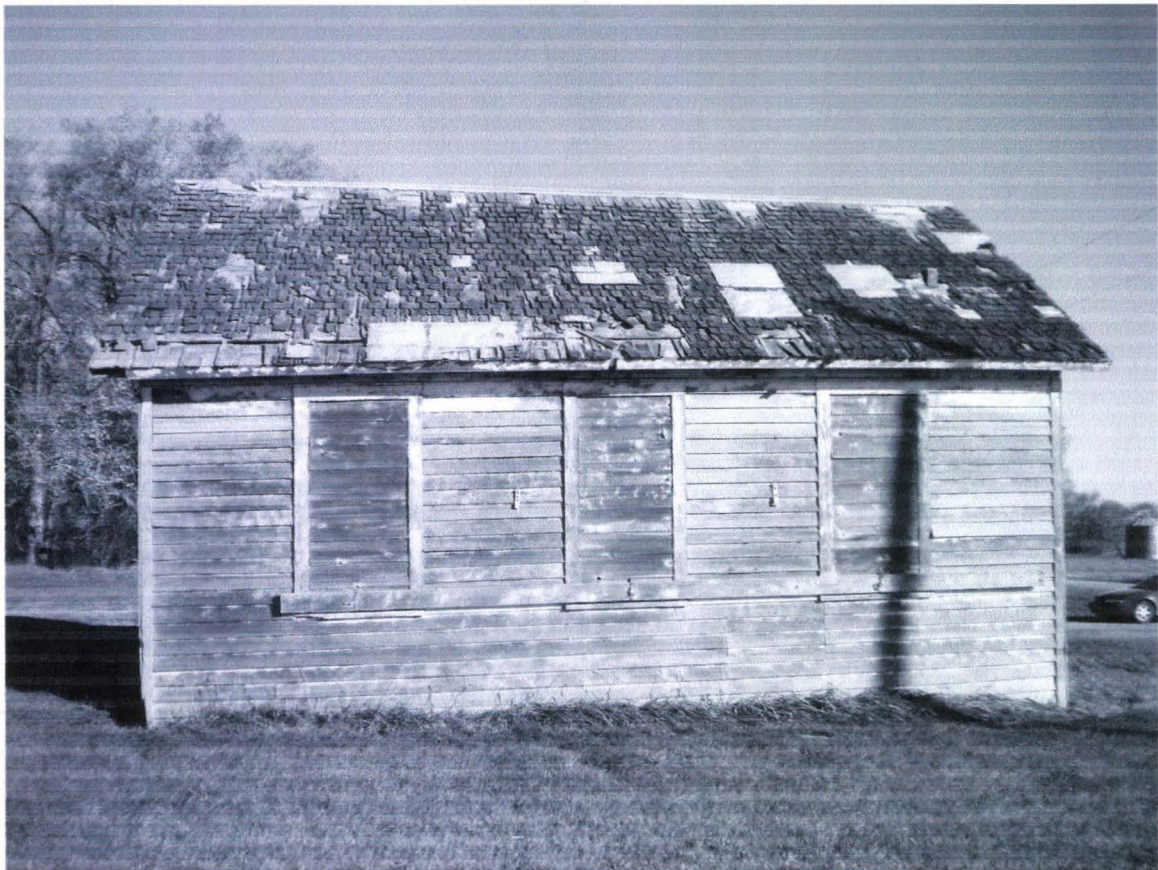

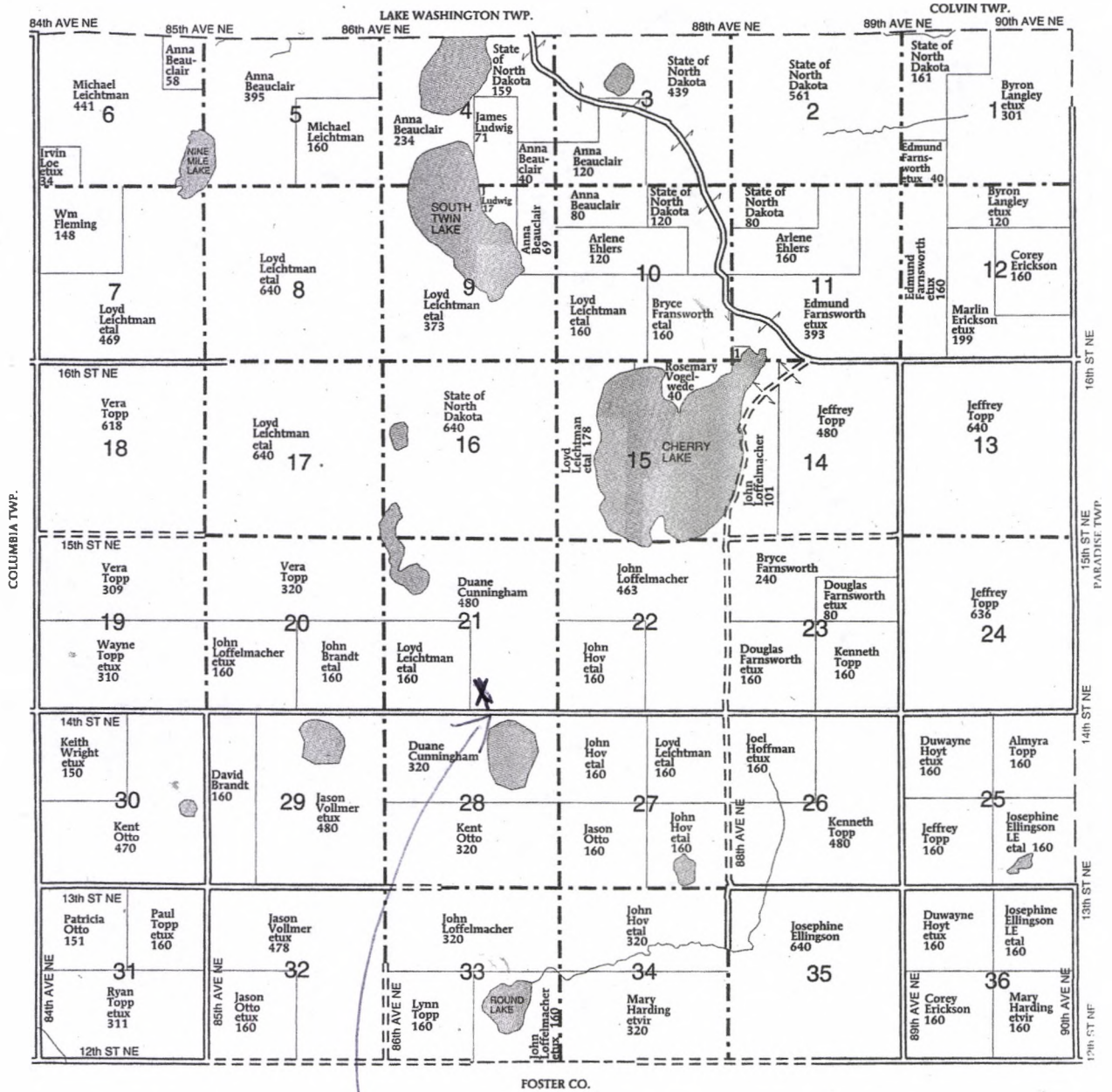
STATUE OF LIBERTY HISTORY
