#### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

This prairie school measures 28 feet east to west and 18 feet 4 inches north to south. The school has wood lap siding with most of the paint weathered away. On the east side of the school an opening was cut to give access to the school for large item storage. This door is made of wood planks hung on a sliding rail so the door can be moved to the south. The original solid wood door can be seen on the same side as this sliding door. There are three double hung windows on both the north and south walls. The glass is intact in all the windows. There are wood shakes on the roof and many of those are missing. No chimney on this building.

The school retains its wood floor. Electricity was available for this building with evidence of light fixtures and a light switch by the door. The walls are manufactured wallboard with wainscoting bead board on the ceiling. Interesting ceiling as they angled ceiling material from near the top of the wall in toward the center at about a 45 degree angle and then finished the flat part of the ceiling all with the same material. On the west wall remnants of a chimney can be seen.






