#### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

This wood lap sided school building measures 24 feet north to south and 34 ½ feet east to west. There are 4 inch trim boards at the corners and a wide trim board at the roof line. There is a fair amount of paint on this building. It is in town and used for storage so that might explain why there is more paint than most. The east side of the school has a door in the center, it is wood door but I don't think it is original. There is an enclose space above the door that looks like there was a transom window at one time. There also two windows on this side as well, both with glass intact. On the north side there are 5 large windows, double hung with glass intact. Another smaller window toward the east end looks to be a replacement window. Two more windows are on the west wall.

Asphalt shingles cover the roof and look to be in fair condition from the outside but once inside the school there are lots of small holes letting in a lot of daylight. The floor, where it is not missing, has 9"x9" tiles covering the wood. There are blackboards running the entire length of the south wall and another at the southeast corner. There are doors at the entry of the school, perhaps coatrooms. Some coat hooks in the entry area. All the walls and ceiling are finished with sheet rock. There is a rail around the room but no wainscoting.

This building is used for storage and it is full.

The school was moved to its present location and there is no information about where it came from or a name for the building.




