1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a cement block foundation. It was moved into a farm yard. The hip roof is covered with wood shakes with metal capping. There is a yellow brick chimney with a flue located on the northwest slope of the roof of the school.

The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim, all painted red. On the southeast side an overhead garage door was installed. On the southwest side there is one small 4 pane window near the northwest end of the school. Also on the southwest side are 6 larger, double hung 4 over 4 windows with the glass largely intact. The farm yard was protected by a gate and I did not go in.

Access to this school is south of Hazelton to 65th St SE. Go west on 65th St SE 7 miles to see this school in the farm yard. The school has buildings and trees all around.

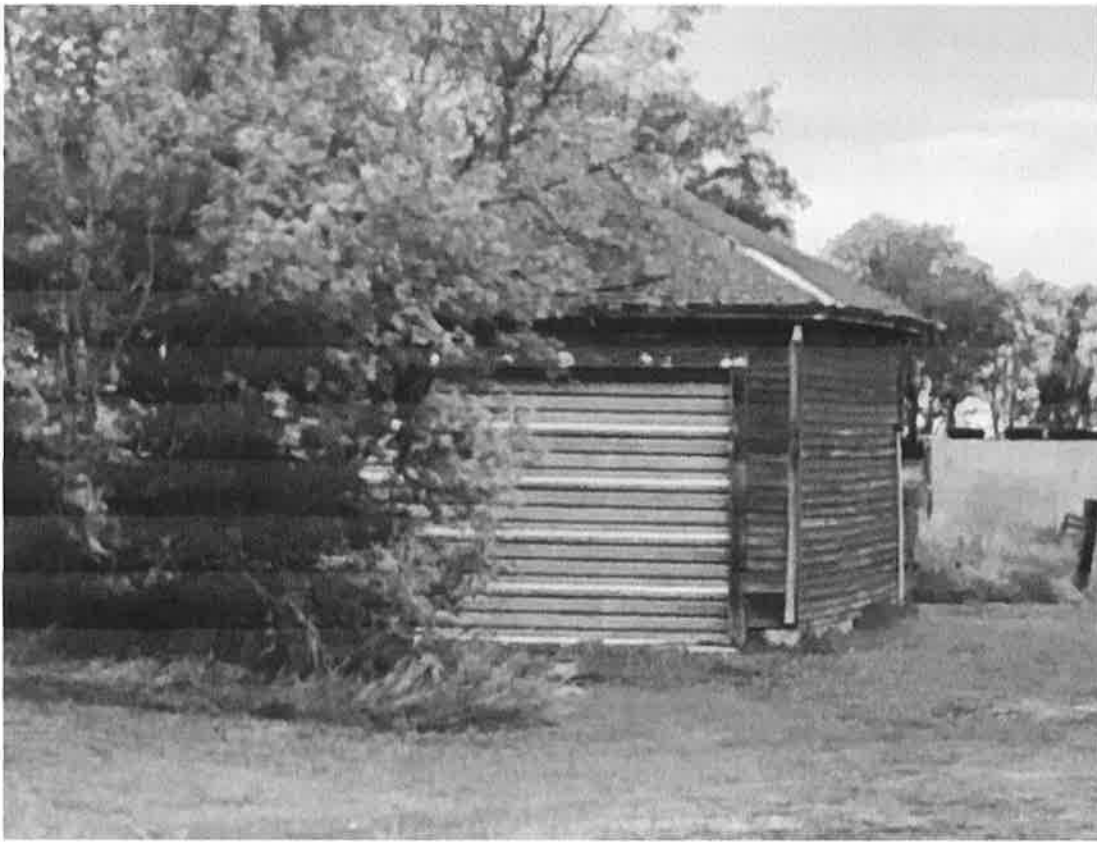

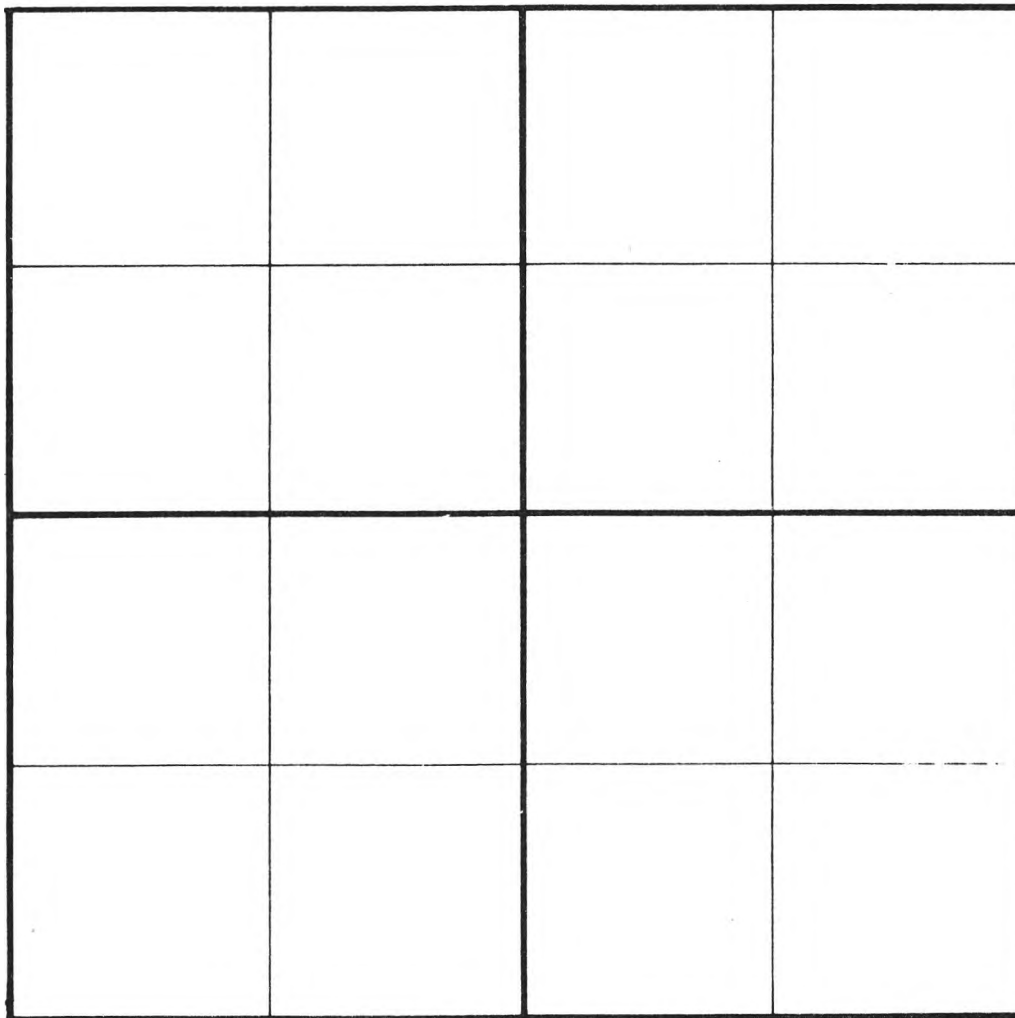
