This one room prairie school is located at its original site. According to Foster County history the school was built in October 1911 as a school, community center and voting place. The siding is 6 inch lap without a shred of paint. 6 inch lumber finishes the corners. The chimney is missing. Shakes mostly cover the roof. Every window opening is boarded up as this building was later used as a grainary. The cut holes on the west end for access to the interior. There is also an opening on the north side of the building, might have been where a window used to be.

The floor is hard wood tongue and groove. The interior finish on the walls and ceiling were all stripped out so they could fill it up with grain. Along the east and west walls are long boards with anchors through them and this connects to large cables that run through the building to keep it together.

No signs of electricity at this school. The school district reorganized in 1960 and they no longer used the building as a school.

The history book listed the cost of materials. Lumber was \$150.00, furniture cost \$3.00, the stove was \$7.00 and painting the school cost \$42.50.

A side note on this building, the owner told me it was probably going to be torn down this fall.

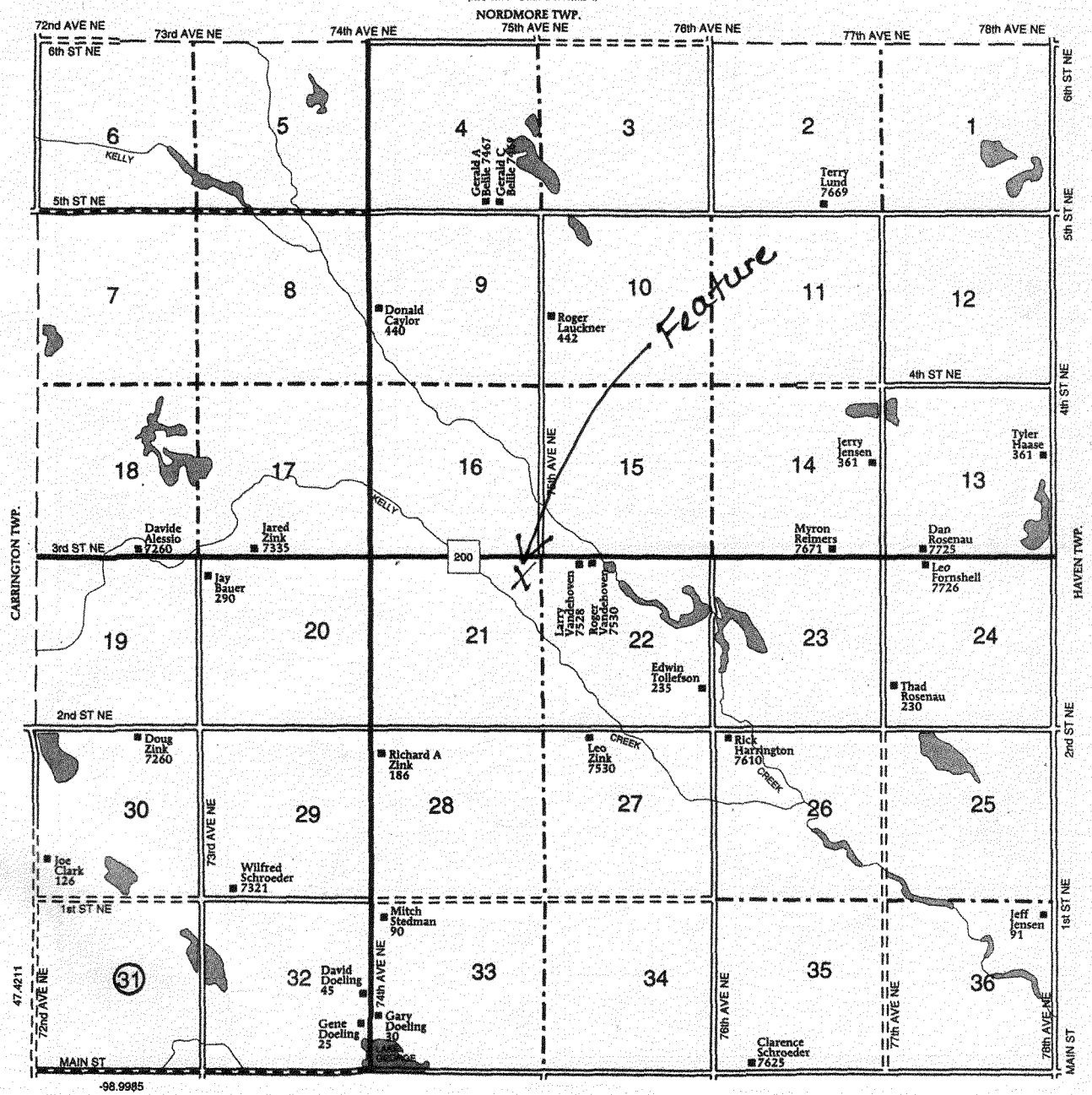
