The feature is a one room school on a foundation of poured concrete and concrete blocks. The school was moved to this location in 1960, two years after the school closed in 1958. The roof is covered with metal sheeting and the chimney is gone. The soffits are closed. The building measures 18 feet south to north and 30 feet east to west.

A wide trim board runs under the eaves on all sides of the school. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with metal corner trim. The school has 6, four pane, double hung windows on the south wall, all glass intact. On the east wall there are two smaller double hung windows to the left of the 5 panel wood entry door. These windows are for the bathrooms. One more double hung window is to the right of the door. Again, all glass intact. There is a wood platform porch that leads to the entry door. Stepping into the school there is a coatroom to the immediate right and bathrooms are to the left. The walls in the entry are covered with fiberboard and coat hooks are on the west wall of the entry. A 5 panel wood door leads from the entry into the boys toilet, the girls toilet access door is in the school room proper. Another 4 panel wood door leads into the school room. The walls in the main room of the school are also covered with celotex board panels. The lower 1/3 of the wall covered with plywood and painted a different color to act as wainscot. The ceiling is finished with celotex board, tile look. There are two hanging lights with large white globes indicating electricity present. Blackboards are either side of the wood burning stove at the west end of the room. The floors are tongue and groove hardwood.

The school is furnished with maps, desks, teachers desk, a flag on the wall, picture of George Washington, some school memorabilia and more. The original cost of the building was \$248.36 and the land, 2 acres, was bought from Helga Herlickson for \$10. The first year furnishings cost \$50.15. School restoration was completed in 1967 and over 1000 folks have visited and signed the guest book.

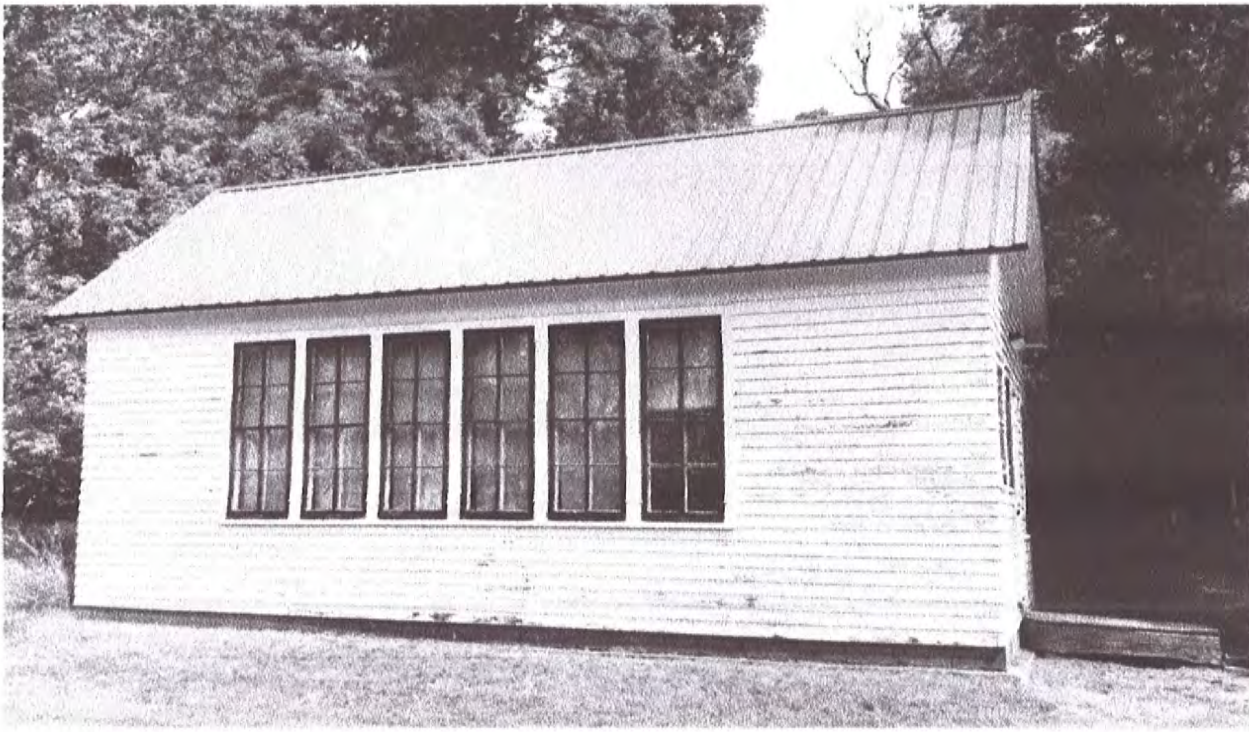

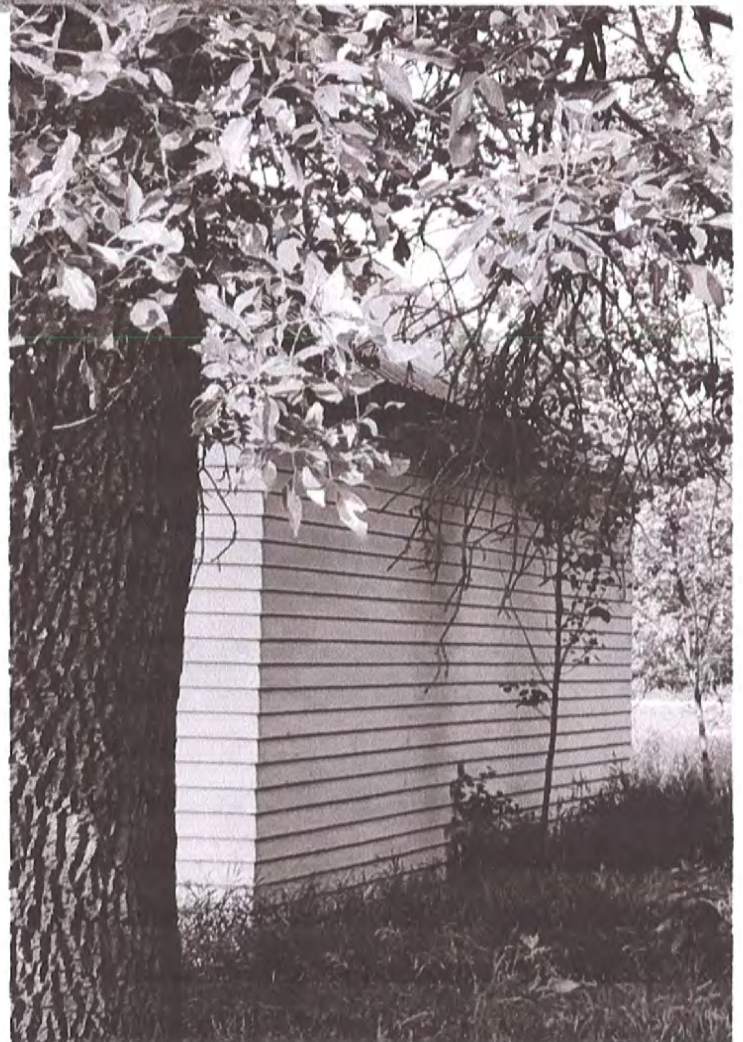

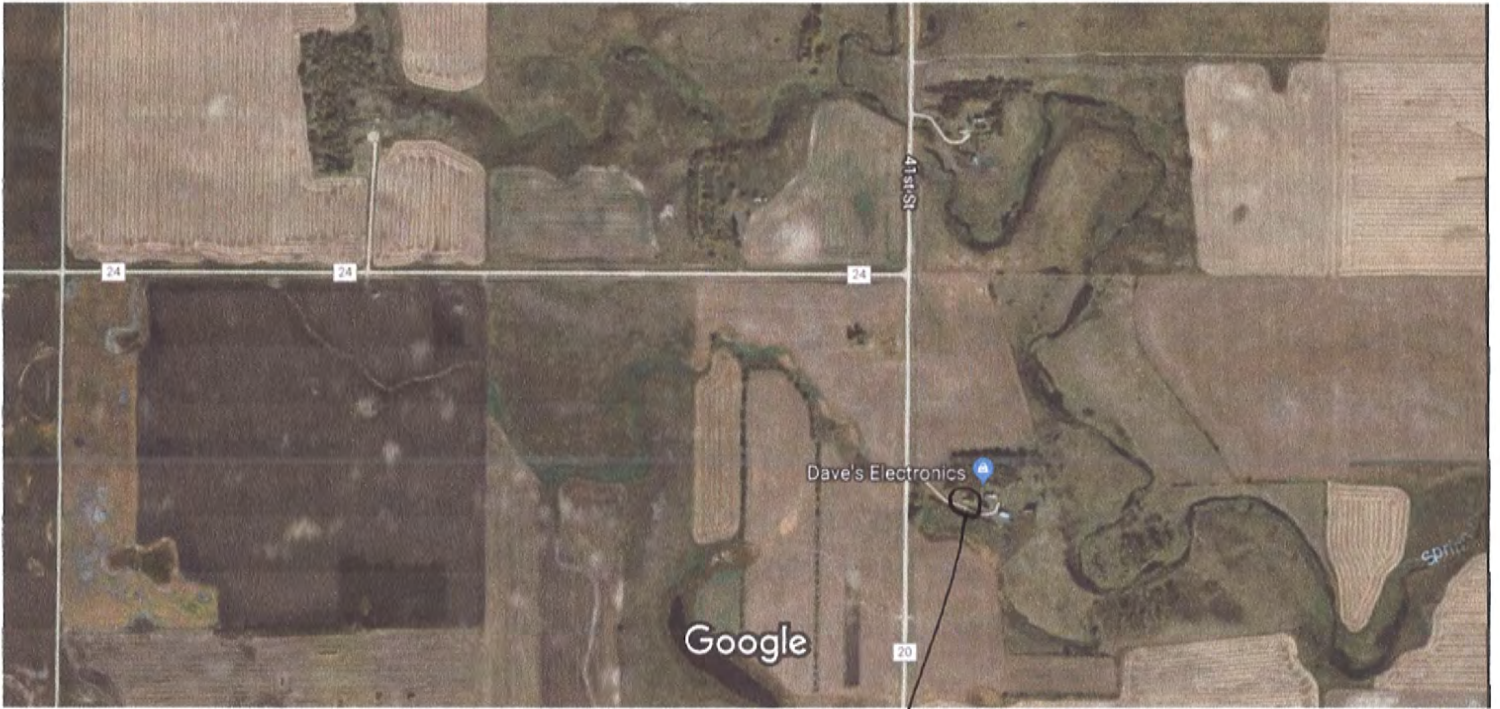
