1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on concrete block foundation in its original location. The roof line of this school features two intersecting gables, the north/south part of the school is near the west end of the building. The roof is covered with wood shakes with metal capping at the peaks and finials at the ends. There is a large, red and yellow brick chimney located on the outside wall of the west side. The soffit is closed. This building was later used as a shop/garage.

A rake board runs under the peaks of the school sections as well as the entry. 6 inch wood lap siding and 4 inch corner trim complete the siding. An entry, with a broken 5 panel wood door, is located at the east end of the school, reached by concrete steps and a porch. Either side of the concrete porch are metal hand rails. There is one small, covered opening on the south wall of the entry. The main body of the school has lathe and plaster on the walls with a mix of lathe and plaster and wallboard finishing the ceiling. Much of the ceiling is falling in. A sliding door was installed along the south wall of the school, giving access to the interior for vehicles. Also on the south wall is one double hung windows with some glass. Four more double hung windows are located on the west wall with some glass as well as framing. There are also remnants of middle pull windows shades on these windows. There are two small windows at the east edge of the north wall in what looks like a shed addition. Speculation is that this shed addition was a room for the teacher. There is yet one more windows opening on the east wall of the shed addition. Inside the school room there is a door to the right leading into the shed addition and this is a 5 panel wood door. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There were blackboards on the north and east walls of the, one blackboard remains on the east wall. Wainscot, painted teal blue, is located along most of the walls. A light fixture above the entry door and hanging lights inside the school indicate electricity.
