This feature is a one room wood framed prairie school on a concrete basement. The roof of the building is covered with asphalt shingles in good repair. There is a red brick chimney on the south facing slope of the roof with a bathroom vent pipe located on that same slope. The eaves have enclosed soffits all sides. There is a small roof over the entry, the roof is a half hip. The building measures 36 feet north to south and 22 feet east to west.

A wide header is located under the eaves on all sides. Siding is 6 inch wood lap with metal corner caps. The paint is in pretty good shape. All the windows are covered but in researching this school I learned that the 5 windows on the east wall are multipane, double hung large windows. More windows are on the south facing wall, smaller double hung windows. Two more windows on the north side are also double hung. These windows provided light for the stairwell that ran down stairs along the north wall. There is a new, security entry door on the north side, reached by concrete steps with wooden rails. There are more windows around the walls of the basement, all covered. On the west end of the south side is a fuel delivery door. The heat in the school was lastly fuel oil and that stove was on the main floor in the school room. The main entry has wide concrete steps up to a concrete platform that is under the cover of a small roof held up at the east edge by columns. Concrete forms railing/edges along the north and south of the steps. There is a wood half wall that is on both the north and south sides of the top concrete platform. There is another new security door at this entrance.

Inside the main entry of the school is a small area that then leads to the right into the main body of the school. On the south wall of the main body are two more doors leading into a boys or girls bathroom with coatroom rooms first and bathroom on the south wall. The walls in the school are of lather and plaster with sheet rock finishing the ceiling. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. In the northeast corner of the school room was a small room used for a library. Along the north wall to the door at the northwest corner of the school was one of the blackboards. Another was located along the entire west wall of the main body of the school. In the basement was a kitchen stove so the teacher could prepare hot meals for the students. Electric wires run to the school wall on the west side and there are light fixtures in the school.

There are a few desks in the school along with a teachers desk. A few books remain in the library. This school hosts a picnic every summer and they invite past students and teachers to attend.

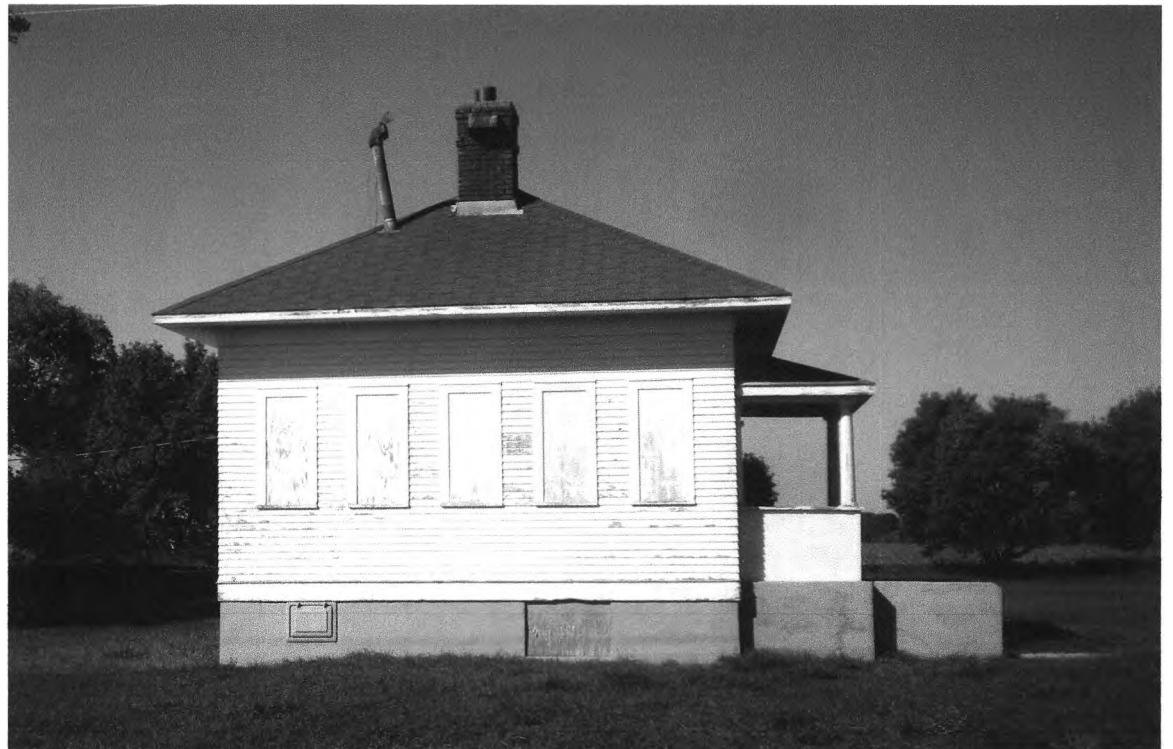

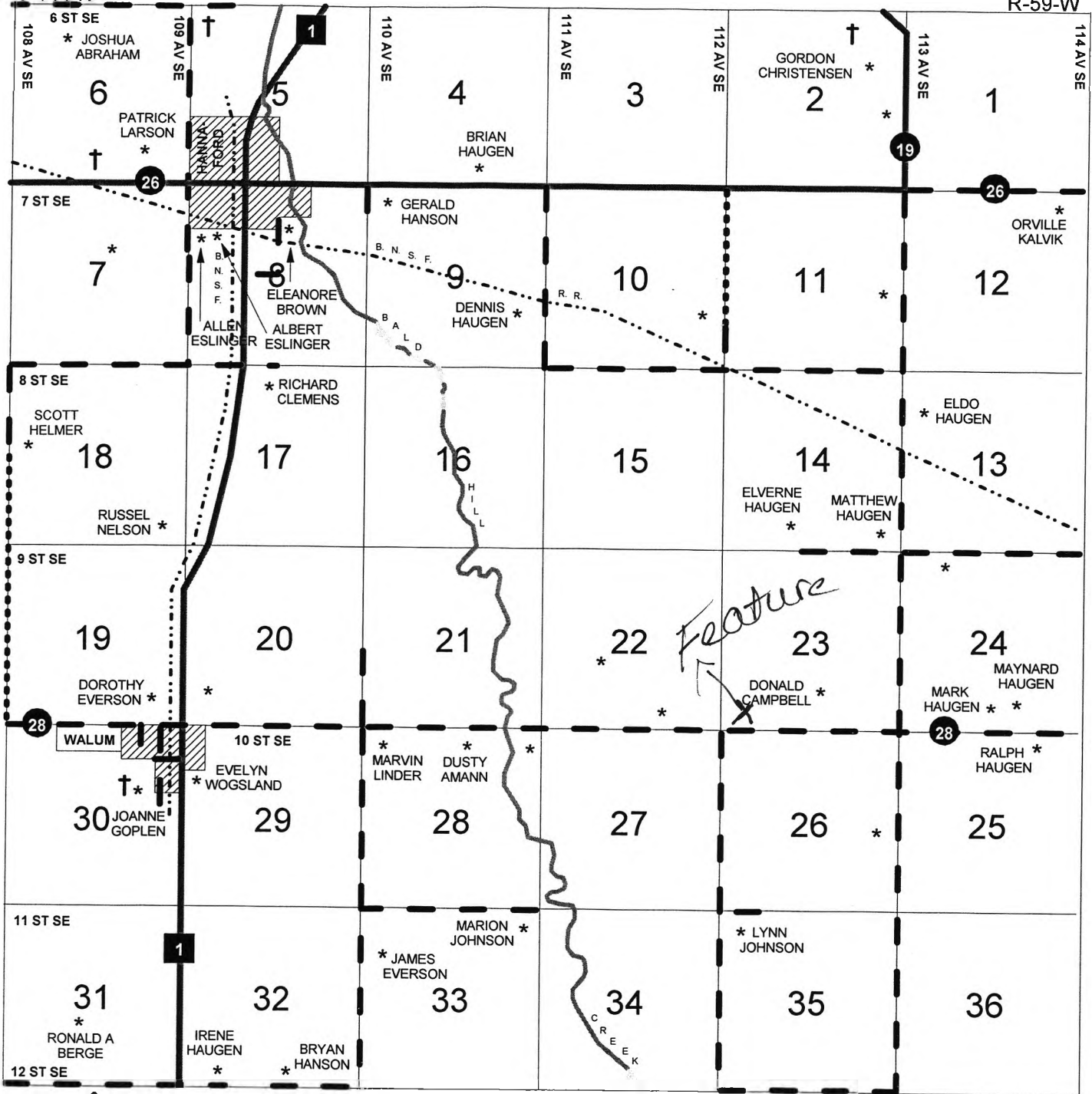
