1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

This feature is a simple, wood framed one room prairie school sitting on a foundation of a mix of concrete and blocks. The roof of the main body is covered with asphalt shingles. There is no chimney. the shed roof on the addition to the north is covered with metal sheeting. The eaves have closed soffits. The building measures 44 feet north to south and 20 feet east to west.

There is a wide header under the eaves at both peaks of the school as well as under the eaves of all three sides of the addition. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. There is a vent at the south end of the building near the peak. On the south side of the school there is a 5 panel wood entry door, with a concrete step up to it. Either side of the door are two pane double hung windows with intact glass. More 2 pane double hung windows on both the east and west sides of the school. Only two of the windows are coveres with plywood. On the east side there is small door, no idea what that is for. The shed addition has one 4 pane fixed window on the south side, two small fixed pane windows on the east end of the north side and two more on the west side. The interior of the school is used for storage. In the addition there is some lathe and plaster and some bead board on the walls. The area is divided into two parts by a 5 panel wood door. The main body and entry of the school have lathe and plaster on the ceilings and walls. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There is a door into the shed addition at the east end of the north interior wall of the school room. The north wall also has a blackboard the rest of the width. There is remnants of the chimney in the school at the north end.I see wainscoting in the entry, can see inside the school for that. Electricity is presnet as incidated by wiring on the outside of the building.






