The feature is a large one room prairie school sitting on concrete foundation. The school is located in what was a small town called Karnak in Broadview Township. The hip roof has tired asphalt shingles with various types of metal capping. The top of the hip roof has metal capping with finials, the gables run from the hip roof to the eaves have capping that ranges from long metal pieces to metal corner caps. There is a concrete block chimney on the west slope of the roof and another metal pipe, perhaps for bathroom venting. The eaves have enclosed soffits.

There is a large header board all four sides of the school, just under the eaves. Another wide board trims the bottom of the siding, also all four sides. The siding is wood lap with metal corner trim. I did not get close to this building. There is a porch on the west end of the south side, hip roofed with columns supporting this small roof. The sides of the porch look to be box shaped with lap siding to finish. This leads to a four panel wood door. The west side has 5 double hung, 4 pane windows. The south side had 5 larger, 6 pane double hung windows. The east end also has two more of the small, 4 pane double hung windows. All glass is intact. There is another door on the east side of the school, looks to be a simple wood door.

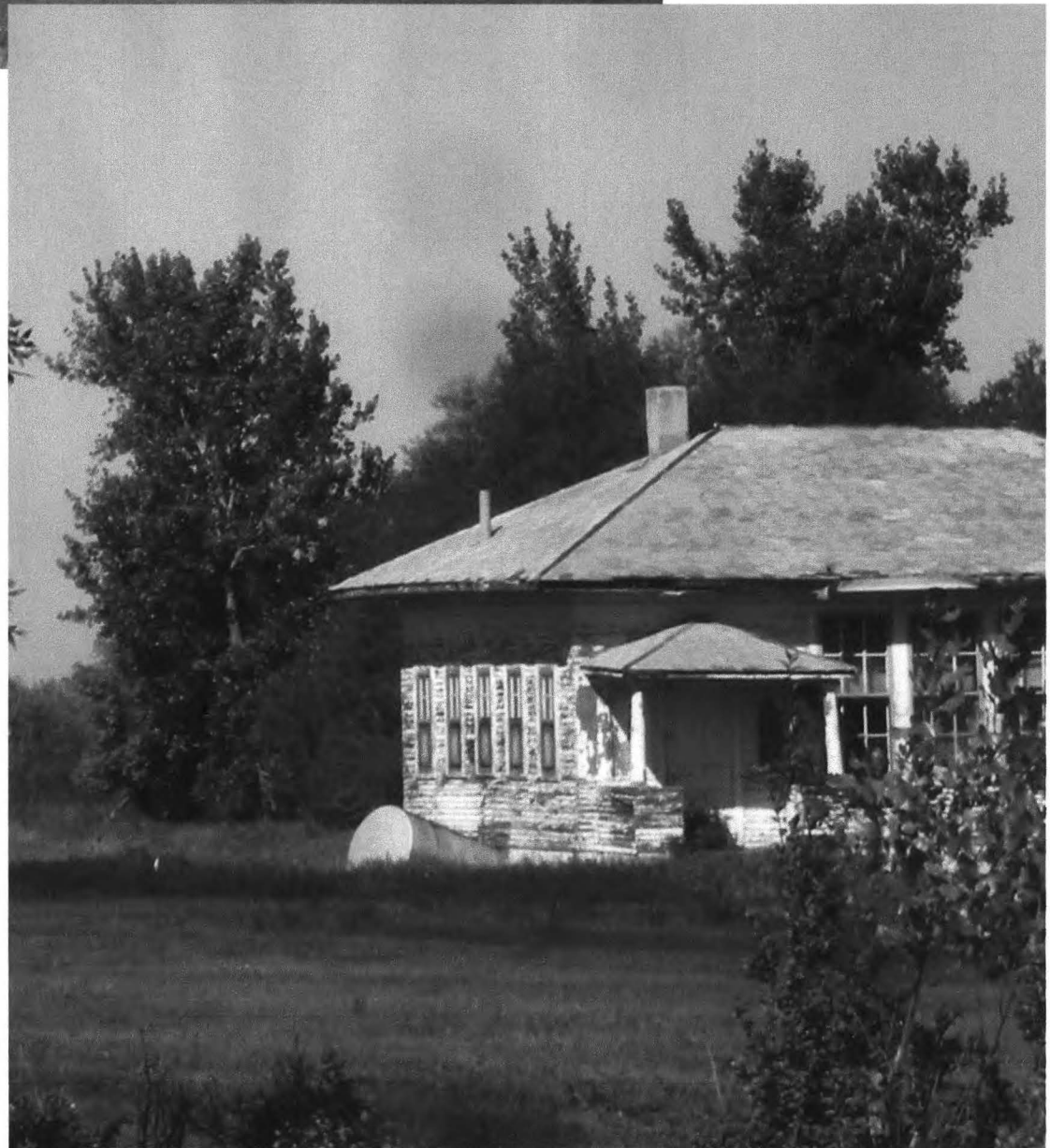

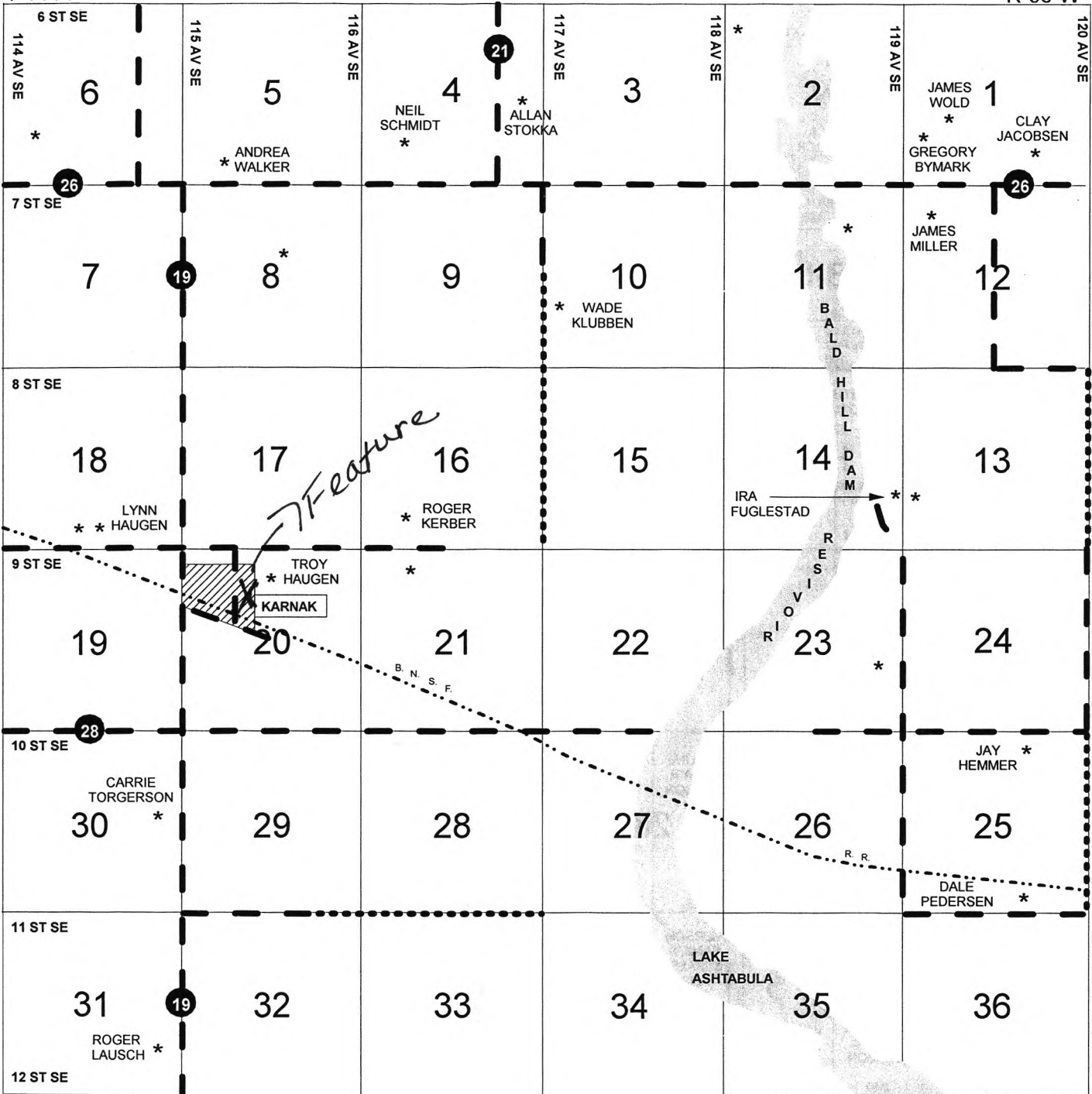
