1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

This feature is a one room wood framed prairie school that is sitting on a poured concrete foundation. The school was moved to the current location from about 3 miles away. The Township felt it was a better location for their meeting hall. It is now a part time residence for out of state owners.

The roof of this school is covered with newer asphalt shingles. Shingles cap the top and all four seams. There is a concrete block chimney on the seam between the south and east slopes. The soffits on this school are open. There is a small half hip roof over the entry door, held up by wood brackets. The building measures 24 feet easterly to westerly (the school sits at an angle) and 36 feet northerly to southerly. (My pictures are not true directions but close enough.....the front is more Southwesterly)

The siding is 6 inch wood lap with great paint. The corners have metal corner caps. The entry door is a sold, security door with a screen door, reached by way of a one step wood platform. The platform has wood rails either side. Either side of the entry door are double hung windows, the top has 3 panes and the bottom glass is solid. Two more windows of the same side are at the west end of both the north and south walls. High, under the eaves, on both sides are fixed pane windows, about 8 feet from the south wall. On the west side there are 6 windows, top are three pane and bottom one large pane.

The interior of the school has about an 8 foot hallway into the main body of the school. There are solid walls along the hallway and the doors for the small rooms either side of the entry are in the main body of the school. These were coat rooms, boys and girls separate. One of the coatrooms had a bathroom, the other had stairs that went down to the basement this school sat on at a former location. The owners of the building today have had the staircase area go up to a loft. The walls and ceiling in the school are lather and plaster. The blackboard remains on the east wall. The floor is the original tongue and groove hardwood. There is wainscoting in the school and also electricity. A light fixture outside the school and the wires running to it are indicative of power.


