This feature is a one room prairie school with a foundation of railroad ties. It was moved to the present location for use as a motorcycle club and later storage. The building measures 36 feet west to east and 18 1/2 feet north to south. Roofing material is asphalt shingles with no chimney visible. An 8 foot header runs under each gabled end of the school. The remainder of the siding of the school is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. There is a vent on the west end, off to the north side closer to the peak as well as an opening for a chimney on that same wall. A large light fixture at the southwest corner of the building as well as over the entry door on the east end shows electricity was present at one time. There are wires and a meter near the southeast corner as well. There is one newer, crank out window on the south side in what looks to have been a window opening. Three more window openings on the south side are covered by plywood. More windows are along the north wall, three are covered and in the middle of the wall there is an uncovered, double hung window with intact glass. The window spaces on both walls, near the east end of the building appear to be in the entry area. The solid core door on the east end was locked. The window on the north side allowed me a look inside the building. The floor is hard wood. The walls are covered with wallboard and this covers most of the windows from the inside, all painted white. The ceiling is covered with large tiles.
