1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a large, one room prairie school that was moved to a farm yard and placed on a concrete pad. The hip roof of this school is covered with wood shakes. The hips are closed with metal capping and the peak has metal capping with finials. The roof of the entry is covered with wood shakes and metal capping covers the hips that come from a platform at the top that may have held a bell and still have the flag pole. There are a few pieces a widow's walk at the top of the entry. I can't tell if the entry was built into the main roof or if the roof was built around the entry, the west side sort of overlaps. An 8 foot wide header is located just under the roof overhang on all four sides of the school as well as the front of the entry. The soffits are closed. The outside walls are covered with 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood comer trim. On the west wall there is a trim board between the main body of the school and the entry. There is watertable trim about 4 feet up from the bottom of another wide trim board. Much of the east wall of the building was removed to accommodate a large, overhead door. This wall originally contained the windows for the school. On that same wall there is conduit covered wire showing electricity was there at one point. The north wall has one small window near the northwest comer and two more windows, all glass gone, are either side of the door of the entry. That door is falling apart. It looks like there might have been a large transom above that door at some point. The interior walls are a mixture of things today, some tin, some wallboard and some lathe and plaster with wainscot on one wall. The ceiling is a misture of wall board and beadboard. There used to be a blackboard along the entire north wall and perhaps the south wall to the entry. The entry is lathe and plasert with tongue and groove flooring. The door from entry into the main body of the school is set at an angle.




