Helena School #3, also known as Revere School, is a one room prairie school. The building sits on a poured concrete foundation. This building has a hip roof for the main body of the school and a gable roof on the entry. All roofing is covered with wood shakes, finished with metal capping and finials. Remnants of the yellow brick chimney can be seen on the southeast facing slope of the roof. Under the peak end of the entry roof there are decorative fish scale pieces above a small slanted roof piece that extends from one side to the other of the gable roof. There is a cupola on the top of the entry roof, a box shape extends up to hold the conical roof with a flag pole at the top. It is really a great looking piece as so many have been destroyed.

The soffits are all closed with bead board. There is a wide trim board just under the roof on all four sides with 6 inch wood lap siding covering all the walls. 6 inch wood trim finishes the corners. The bottom of the outside walls have water table trim. Access to the entry door is up concrete steps to a concrete platform inside the open entry area. The entry is open with 5 foot walls extending out from the school and 2 foot walls on each side of the open area, decorative in the placement. The 5 panel entry door has sidelights as well as three panes of glass running across the 8 feet of the entry. Stepping into the school you find yourself in a foyer area with three doors leading to the left, right and straight ahead. None of the doors remain. All three of those doors have transoms above them. The left or right doorways lead into coat room space with openings leading into the school room. The third door leads directly into the school room. In each corner of the southeast side of the school there are rooms which appear to be storage rooms and/or library. Both of these rooms have 5 panel doors still intact. The coat rooms and storage rooms each have one double hung window, some framing remains in a couple but there is no glass. The main room of the school has two double hung, small windows on the southwest wall and 4 large double hung windows on the northwest wall. All of the glass is missing and there is little framing left. The inside of the windows have decorative moldings at the top. Walls are covered with two kinds of wallboard (fiber board) above vertical wainscot. Above the wainscot about 3/4 of that space of wall board has decorative lines running horizontally and the top couple feet have what looks like wall board tiles, painted green and yellow. The ceiling is covered with ceiling 12 inch accoustical tiles. Chains with part of the light fixtures are hanging from the ceiling, indicates the presence of electricity.. There is a blackboard on the northeast wall. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. The heating source is not longer in the school The school measures 28 feet northeast to southwest and 32 feet southeast to norwest. The entry measures 5 feet by 8 feet.

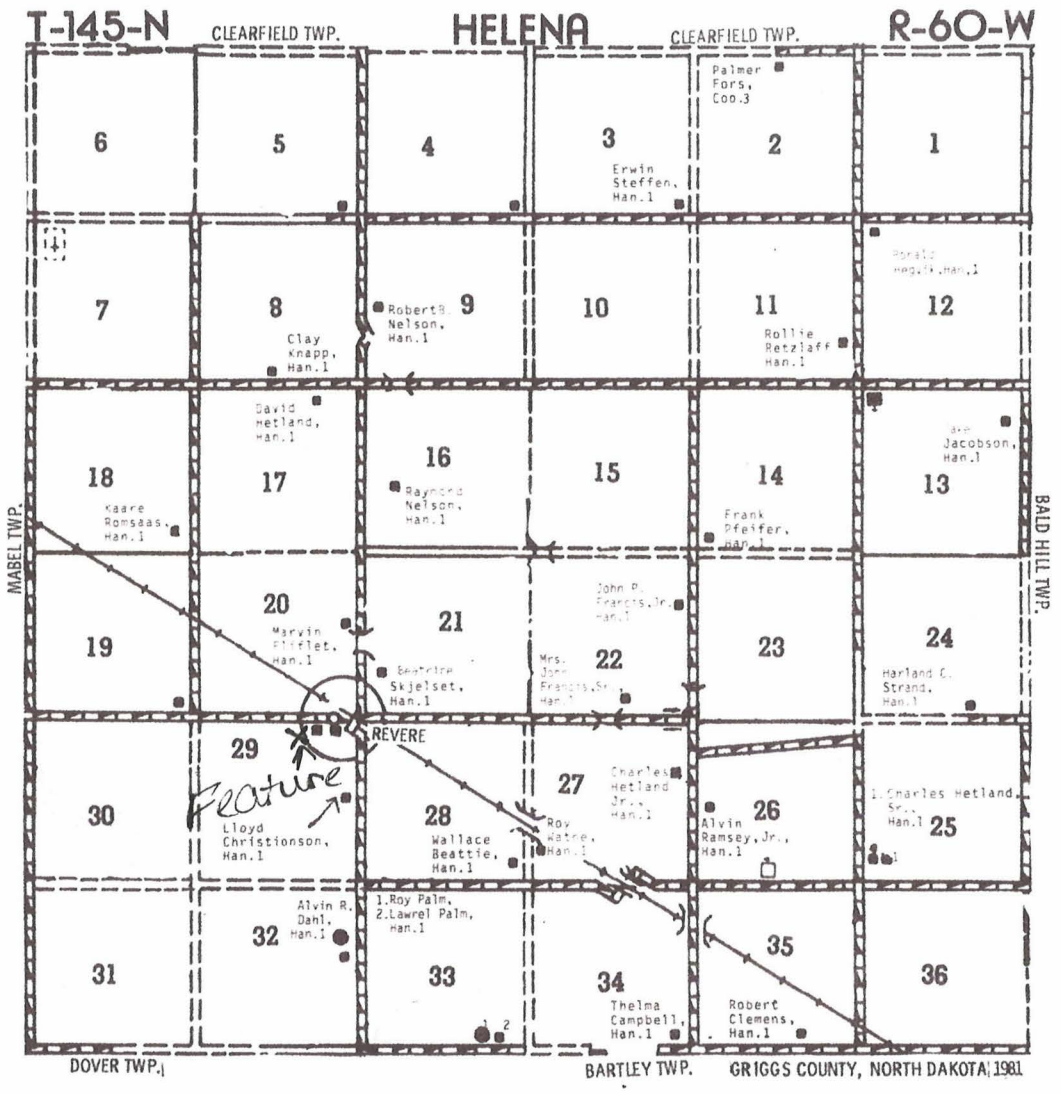
