#### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school that was moved from its original location. It is sitting on an abandoned farm site. The school measures 28 feet west to east and 18 feet north to south. The roof of the school is covered with asphalt shingles and the leanto at the west end is roofed with metal but much of it is falling in. There is a wide trim board under the roof at the peaked ends of the school. No evidence of a chimney on this building. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch corner trim boards. The leanto at the west end of the school is separating from the building and saggin to the west. There is a door on the south side of the leanto that is falling off its hinges. The school has three windows on both the north and south sides. The windows are double hung and uncovered on the south side with all three on the north side covered. The door, a five panel wood door, on the east end of the school is locked so we were unable to see inside the building. A look in the windows did not tell me anything about the structure inside.
