#### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school measuring 16 feet north to south and 30 feet east to west. That includes the entry. The roof is covered with shakes and there is a remnant of a chimney at the west end of the building. It was moved 1/2 mile to the present location. There is a wide trim board on the east end under the peak of the roof. The siding on the north, west and south sides was replaced with permanent siding and the siding on the east side is 6 inch lap siding. There are two fixed pane, small windows on the south side of the building. Electricity is present, a line runs from a pole to wiring on the west end of the building. There is a very tired 5 panel wood door leading into the building. Stepping into the entry a window can be seen to the right, covered with the replaced siding. The floor is tongue and groove hard wood. Inside the main room of the school is more beadboard on the ceiling and walls. There is one light fixture inside the school. On the south wall I can see where 6 windows were before the small windows were added and the siding was placed over the openings. According to a pupil of the school the blackboard was at the west end of the room. The building has been used for grain storage and other storage. Janesburg School District #32 started building schools in 1917 and the last one closed in 1963.


