1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school sitting on a farm site. The school was moved to this location to be used for storeage. The school measures 28 feet east to west and 20 feet north to south. The east facing entry measures 16 feet north to south and 8 feet east to west. There is a gable roof on the school with the entry on the east gable roofed at a 90 degree angle to the school. All the roof is covered with shakes and metal ridge cap runs the peak of both roofs. There is a brick chimney on the south slope of the entry. A wide trim goard runs under the enclosed soffits all around the school. The siding is 6 inch lap siding with 4 inch wood corner trim boards. There are 5 double hung windows on the west side of the building, no glass. More windows on the south side, 3 double hung, also without gladd. Two smalled double hung windows face east and the door is in the middle. Stepping into the entry there is wall board on the walls and ceiling. Tongue and groove hardwood flooring throughout the building. More wall board on the ceiling and walls in the main room of the school. The blackboard was on the north wall of the school. There are remnants of light fixtures indicating electricity. The building is full of junk today. Janesburg Township School District #32 started building schools in 1917 and the last one closed in 1963.


