### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a large, two room school built much like the one room prairie schools. The building measures 28 feet east to west and 56 1/2 feet north to south. The entry measures 22 feet north to south and 15 feet from east to west. The roof is covered with fairly new asphalt shingles. The includes the hip roof of the main part of the school, the gable roof on the entry and the cupola. There is a flag pole at the topf of the cupola. It looks like there were windows in the cupola, covered with plywood today. A brick chimney completes the roof. The siding is 4 inch lap with 6 inch corner trim boards. A wide trim board runs all around the school just under the soffit of the roof. The school has windows on the north and the south walls with more to the east. There are 5 multipane, double hung windows on the north and south with walls, three of the 5 on each wall are covered. There are two east facing windows in the entry, either side of a double door. Several poured concrete steps lead up to the entry. The entry doors are plywood with a newer doorknob. Above the door, in the angle of the gable roof is a half moon shape that might have been a window, now covered with wood. There are four more windows on the east side of the school two each either side of the entry, all covered with wood. The foundation sits out of the ground about 4 feet and there are windows on the south, west and north sides. Also on the north side basement wall is a fuel door. Inside the school there is an entry with stairs to the left and right. The right stairs lead to a furnace room at the north end of the building and the left stairs leads to a room that was sometimes used for a third class room. Back in the entry there are wood steps leading up to the class room level. Another landing at the top allows you to go to the left or right for entry into the classrooms. The doors leading into the classrooms are paneled wood with glass panes in the upper 1/3. There is a transom window above each door. The floors in the school, including the third basement classroom, are all narrow hardwood. Walls are lathe and plaster and wall board where it was upgraded. The ceiling is also wall board with electric light fixtures hanging in all rooms. There is a divider curtain that can be pulled between the two rooms. Black boards cover the west wall in both classrooms and more blackboards can be seen on the east wall behind the teachers desks. There is a workroom behind the east blackboards in each classrooms. Duct work for the furnace is located between the two rooms, just behind the wall at the top of the landing with heating grates to the north and south for each room. The school is owned by the Grant County Historical Society and it is used for a flea market when they have county events. The historical society is looking to sell the school because of the cost to maintain it. Elm Township School District #17 started building schools in 1917 and the last schoool closed in 1965.


