1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a rock foundation. The gable roof of the school, the shed roof of the entry as well as the pyramidal roof of the bell tower all covered with wood shakes. There is a covered hole at the east end where the chimney used to be. The bell tower has a wood base with lap siding which supports the four sides of the tower, each having a circular opening, topped off by the pyramidal roof. On top of the pyramid is as flagpole. The soffits are closed. The building measures 34 feet east to west and 24 feet north to south.

There is a wide trim board on the exterior wall under the soffits on the peak ends of the roof. The remaining siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. There is a 5 panel door on the south side of the entry, reached by a concrete pad. The entry has two parts with a door to the north that goes into a stripped out room that I suspect was for fuel storage. The entry walls are wallboard with beadboard wainscot. Another door to the right leads into the main body of the school. The interior walls and ceiling are lathe and plaster with much of the ceiling falling away from the lathe. There is beadboard wainscot. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood, mostly covered with wheat. They have used this building for a grainery and storage. There are two openings on the west side of the entry, the south one was a window and the north a fuel door. There are 6 double hung windows, three on the north and three on the south, with all but 1 1/2 shuttered. They have no glass and some are covered from the inside to hold grain. There is one blackboard on the north half of the west wall and places on the south half of that wall as well as the east wall show evidence of others that were removed. No sign of electricity.

This school was built in 1913 and only operated until 1926.
