



1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a concrete foundation. The gable roof of the main body and half hip of the entry are covered with asphalt shingles. There is a short, red brick chimney at the north end of the peak of the roof. The soffits are closed. At the south end of the gable roof there is a bell tower. The bottom support box has 6 inch wood lap siding with four posts holding the top of the tower. There is asphalt shingles on the pyramid roof with a flag pole on the peak. The buildling measures 30 feet north to south and 20 feet east to west.

There is a wide trim board on the exterior wall under the soffits on the peak ends of the roof. The remaining siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. There are three double hung windows on the west and east walls, one is covered and all glass is intact. All windows are covered with screeing. There are two double hung windows either side of the 5 panel wood locked entry door. The interior walls are wall board. The ceiling is covered with beadboard. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. Blackboard are located on either side of thes stove on the north wall. Light fixtures suggest electricity. There is a flag pole in the front yard.

This school was built in 1917 and was owned by P & J Huber from 1917 to 1929. It was also called the Lee School for a well-known landowner, S F Lee. After the school closed at this site is was moved in the late 30's and was called Valley View School and it operated here from 1937 to 1954. The last move was into Sentinel Butte to serve as the country school museum.
