### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a concrete foundation. The gable roof of the school is covered with ribbed metal sheeting. The chimney is red brick and it located at the east end at the peak of the roof. The soffits are closed. The building measures 30 feet east to west and 20 feet north to south with the entry measuring 8 by 12 feet.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits at the peak ends of the building with the remainder of the siding 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. There is an entry porch with a locked, tired wood door. There are three double hung, two over two, windows on both the south and north sides. The north side windows are all shuttered. The windows all have glass. The walls and ceiling of the interior of the school are covered with wallboard. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. Could not see wainscot or blackboard as the building is full of storage. A light fixture at the peak of the entry suggests electricity.

It has been moved to be used for storage, previous location was 142-105-Sec. 28, the northwest corner. It was moved about 5 miles north. The school was built in 1910 and was given to the community. The school name, Bonnie View, was given to the school because it is the Scottish term for beautiful view. The school was one of the longer running schools in Golden Valley County, closing in 1963.

This school was recorded as 32GV22 in its previous location.
