1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a concrete foundation. It was moved to this museum complex to serve as a model for country schools in Golden Valley County. The gable roof of the school is covered with ribbed metal sheeting. There are eaves troughs on the north and south sides with downspouts. There is no chimney. There is a bell tower at the east end of the school at the peak of the roof. The tower perches on the roof with wood lap siding on the base with 4 posts to hold the pyramid roof which is covered with wood shakes. There is a bell in the tower as well as a flag pole at the peak of the tower. The soffits are closed. The building measures 40 feet east to west and 18 feet north to south.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits at the peak ends of the building with the remainder of the siding 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. There are attic vents on the walls at the peak ends. The windows are double hung, two over two with all glass intact. There are two on the east side, three on the north side and three more on the south side. On the southeast corner of the school there is a porch, it is cut into that corner. One pillar is at the very south east corner supports the roof at the south side. There is a ramp leading to a concrete platform that gives entry by way of a 2 panel wood entry door. A 5 panel wood door opens into the school room. The entry and school room walls are covered with wallboard and in the school room partical board forms wainscot below a decorative railing. The ceiling has wallboard tiles. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. The entry is quite large with cupboards, a wash stand and water cooler. The school room has student desks, a teachers desk, a furnace with a lovely furnace surround, maps, blackboards on the west wall and the north and south walls between all the windows wrapping around to the door on both sides, books and much more.

The school was built in 1908 and became operational in 1909, closing in 1963.
