1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a concrete block foundation. The building was moved to this location for used as a shop. The gable roof is covered with ribbed metal sheeting. No chimney. The soffits are closed. The building measures 28 feet east to west and 18 feet north to south.

There is a wide trim board on the exterior wall under the soffits on the peak ends of the roof. The remaining siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. On the east wall of the building is an ovehead door. The south wall has a 3 wood panel door with glass at the top near the east end. A window opening in the middle of the wall is filled in and there is one small window near the west end. On the west side there is a wood entry door at the north end with a window opening beside the door that is filled in. The interior retains the lathe and plaster walls and beadboard wainscot. No blackboard. Light fixtures suggest electricity. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood.

This school was built in 1916 and named Hillside School, served at that location until 1940. It was moved to a new location to be again used as a school from 1943 to 1953.




