1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a concrete foundation. The gable roofs are covered with wood shakes with metal capping and finials. There is a hole at the west end at the peak where the chimney used to be, many of the bricks have fallen into the school. The soffits are closed. The building measures 24 feet east to west by 20 feet north to south. The entry measures 8 feet by 8 feet.

There is a wide trim board on the wall under the soffits aon all the peak ends. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. On the north wall there were two windows that have been filled in and sided over. The west wall has 4 double hung, two over two, windows that have some glass and are covered with metal sheeting. The south wall also has 4 double hung, four over four, windows that are shuttered with wood, some of that glass remains. A 5 panel wood door leads into the entry. This entry may have been added at a later date as the three entry walls are wallboard with the fourth being the school wall with original lap siding. Another 5 panel wood door leads into the main room of the school. The walls are covered with wallboard. The ceiling has wallboard that looks like tiles, attached to the lathe, beginning to fall away. The floor is tongue and groove hard wood. A bed inside the school suggests use as a house or hunting lodge. There are light fixtures on the ceiling suggesting electricity.

This school was built in 1909 and closed in 1960, it originally sat in section 34 and was moved to the present location when there was a great need for a school 1 mile north.


