1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

This feature is a one room prairie school sitting the original location. There is a newer looking cement block chimney at the west end of the roof. Shakes cover the roof of the school and the side shed as well. The building has 6 inch lap siding with an 8 inch trim boards under the peak. Four inch boards finish the corners. The shed has board lumber sheeting, no lap here. There are double hung windows on both the north and south sides of the school and all but one are uncovered. The glass is intact in all the windows. Boulders/rocks make up the foundation with mortar added in some areas. The shed/entry has a door to the south and two openings on the east wall, perhaps one for fuel delivery and the other might have had glass at some point. I didn't go into the building. I was able to see in the windows of the school through a wire mesh covering all the windows. In the main room of the building I could see tongue and groove flooring, 6 to 8 inch wood planks on all the walls and the ceiling, and no evidence of electricity. There was a blackboard across the entire west wall, around the corners to each window and then more blackboard between the remaining windows. Coat hooks are along the east wall so the entry was for access to the school and fuel storage. On the west wall I saw furnace piping going into the chimney but no furnace.

I visited with a gentleman who lives hear the school and he told me the date the school was built (1886) and also told me the school closed in the 1940's, hence the lack of electricity as it did not get to rural area until the late 1940's. The school was later used for townhall meetings.
