#### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school sitting on a poured, concrete foundation. The roof of both the school and entry are covered with wood shakes and there is a flagpole located at the north end of the main body. The peak of the roof of the school and the entry is covered with metal capping and there are ball finials at all ends. There is an intact, red brick chimney at the east end of the school. This school measures 16 feet north to south and 24 feet east to west. The entry measures 8ft. by 8ft.

There is an 8 inch header running just under the roof at all peaks. The soffits are closed. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 wood corner trim. The paint is getting tired. There are three double hung windows facing south and two more facing east, all appear to have been replaced with smaller, wood framed windows. I think smaller windows because of the wood inset at the top of each of the larger windows. Some glass remains. There is a small, 4 pane window at the west end of the entry. On the north side of the entry there is a covered opening. There are two areas on the south wall, near the east end that appear to be filled in as the seams are not off set. No guess as to what that was all about. A 5 panel door gives access to the entry from a concrete pad/step.

The interior of the coat room shows some hooks remaining. Walls and ceiling are of lathe and plaster and some wallboard. The floo is tongue and groove hardwood. There are blackboards on the north wall and the west wall to the entry door. The walls are showing a lot of water damage. There was electricity as evidenced by light fixtures inside and electric wires outside.

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
