The feature is a one room prairie school that was moved to this location in town. The roof is covered with metal sheeting and there is a cement chimney at the east end of the peak of the roof. The soffits are closed.

An addition was added onto the east end of the school to provide additional space when this school was converted into a house. The siding on the school starts with a rake board under the peak ends of all parts of the building. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. The original entry of the school is located at the west end of the building. There is a solid core entry door that is reached from a platform porch. There is a small 4 pane window on the south wall of the entry. Another door is located at the east end of the building in the new addition. This newer door is reached by three concrete steps that lead up to the screen door. One double hung newer window is located to the north of this door. The addition also has more windows, an upstairs and mainfloor double hung window on the north wall and one more double hung windows on the south wall. The main school room (converted to living space) has two double hung wondows on the south wall and one on the north. One more small window is near the west end of the south wall of the building. Electricity is present.

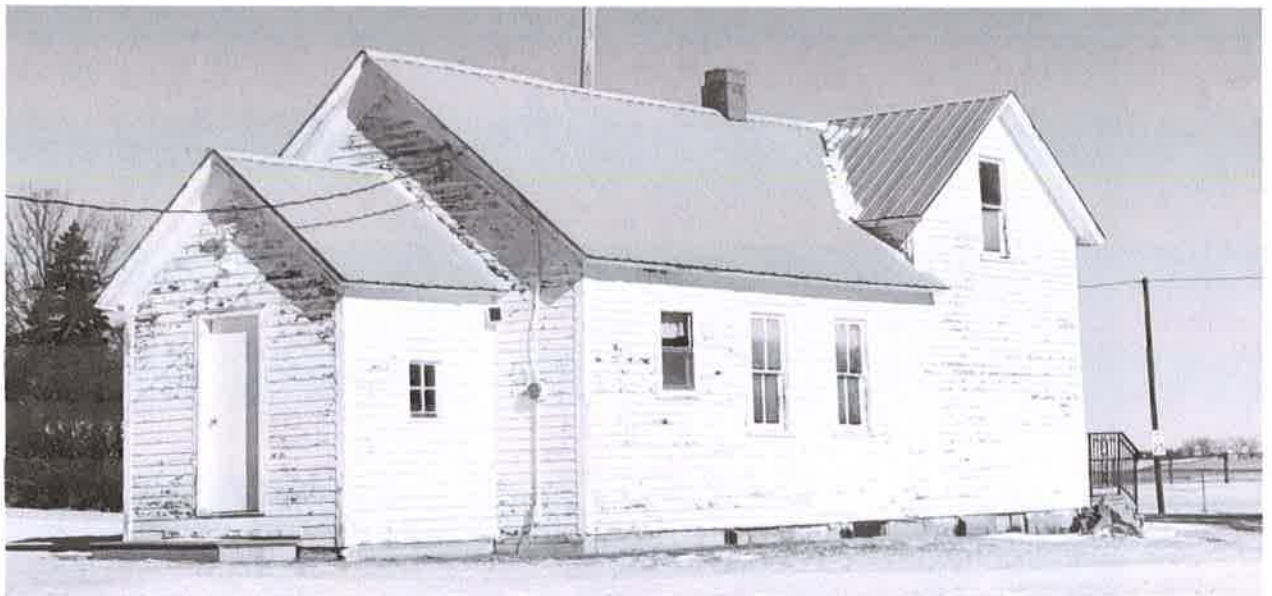
